

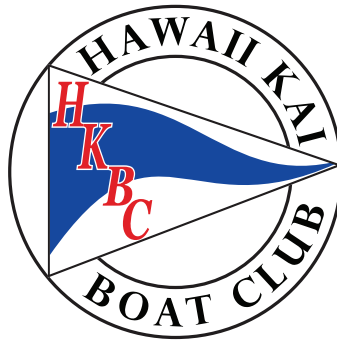

1 Sign in

- 1.1 Each competitor shall sign on as instructed at the All Fleets Briefing to be held at 830hrs on Sunday, May 6, 2018.
- 1.2 Competitors shall sign off within 15 minutes of coming ashore at Alawai Harbor.
- 1.3 A boat retiring shall inform the race committee as soon as possible.


2 Signals Made Ashore

- 2.1 Will be displayed from the main flagmast in front of **HAWAII KAI BOAT CLUB**
- 2.2 When AP  is lowered ashore, the warning signal will be made not less than 30 minutes later. This changes race signals AP.

3 Notices to Competitors

- 3.1 Will be posted on the board located inside **HAWAII KAI BOAT CLUB**
- 3.2 Competitor briefings will be held Island Brew Coffeehouse, 377 Keahole St #C2, Hawaii Kai

4 Changes to the Sailing Instructions

- 4.1 Any change made afloat will be identified with three sound signals. The change will be advised verbally.
- 4.2 Any change made ashore will be identified by the display of International Code Flag L  with 1 sound at least 30 minutes prior to any race affected.

5 Class Flags

5.1 Will not be displaced.

6 Start / Finish and Marks

6.1 The start line is between the RED flag on the race committee boat at the starboard end and Orange mark at the port end.

6.2 The finish line will be between the Red Channel mark and person on the point of Magic Island.

7 Start Sequence – amends rule 26

Pointscore races will be started separately for each fleet.

3 minutes to start "Warning Signal"	3 long horns
2 minutes to start "Preparatory Signal"	2 long Horns
1.5 minute to start	1 long Horn, 3 short horns
1 minute to start	1 long Horn
30 minute to start	3 short Horns
20 minute to start	2 short Horns
10 minute to start	1 short Horn
Start	1 long Horn +

NOTE: Starting Penalties under rule 30, ie: I, Z, Black and U may still be made in conjunction with the 2 minute signal

8 Rules – refer NoR 1

The SI's shall take precedence over the NoR if there is any conflict. Changes rule 63.7.

9 Advertising – refer NoR 2

10 Race Areas/Venue

Refer to NoR 10.

Bronze fleet may sail within the Marina.

11 Scoring – refer NoR 13

A number of novelty type races may be conducted.

12 Eligibility – refer NoR 3

13 Prizes – refer NoR 18 and posted "Change to NOR"

Prizes for novelty type races may be awarded by the OA.
