1 **Relating to:** recognizing the value and need for employment services for individuals

3 Whereas, facility-based programs, such as day programs, training centers, and
4 sheltered workshops, give Wisconsin residents with developmental disabilities the
5 opportunity to gain new skills, meet new people, and make meaningful contributions
6 to society; and

7 Whereas, many Wisconsin residents with developmental disabilities choose to
8 participate in programs offered by facility-based day programs, training centers,
9 and sheltered workshops and receive great personal and social benefit from doing so;

11 Whereas, the parents, guardians, and caregivers of many Wisconsin residents
12 with developmental disabilities are very supportive of facility-based day programs,
13 training centers, and sheltered workshops and can attest to the benefits their
14 programs provide; and
