## Delaware County Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) Collection Events



Household products containing toxic chemicals can be a threat to people and the environment, if improperly discarded. Never dispose of hazardous materials in the trash as they may harm your sanitation workers or result in a collection vehicle fire. It is also not safe to pour them down a sink or storm drain as they end up in the environment polluting the air, water, and soil.

### Think Globally, Act Locally!

Preventing waste in the first place is the best, least expensive method of disposal. With regard to paint, we recommend you follow the options below:

#### Reduce

Buy only what you need and return unopened cans.

#### Reuse

Use leftover paint for a second coat.

#### Recycle

Latex Paints can be blended together to produce beige or gray.

Oil-based paints may also be mixed together; however, *Do Not Mix Oil-Based with Latex Paints.*
