The Howard County Historical Society was founded in 1958 by Alda Hopkins Clark, who is connected to the Clark family, the Hopkins Family, and the Ellicott family in various ways.

He has a keen sense of timing...

Last July 27, 2016 he was completing an art exhibit of Ellicott City floods, and the Flood of 2016 occurred.

The first documented flood was in 1786, with subsequent floods every 7-12 years, and Major Floods every 50 years.

The HC Historical Society received only 1,500 visitors in years past. Now it has over 7,500 visitors.

They have increased their marketing and exposure recently.

They sponsor concert series, Ghost Tours, Pub Crawl Tours.

It is the primary archives of Howard County, located on the second floor of the Miller Branch Library.

Shawn has increased diversity by offering more exhibits in African-American history, and Korean-American history.

He has completed a exhibit, Fractured Howard County: The Civil War.

There were 419 Union and 374 Confederate soldiers from Howard County who fought in the Civil War. The Underground Railroad is highlighted in the exhibit.

The Confederate Memorial behind the Courthouse will be moved off site soon, as requested by the Governor. From 1911-1948, Confederate memorials were constructed as a means of reconciliation. Now, they have a different interpretation.

Finally, the Society is working on a Rehabilitation of the Ellicott Quaker School.
