

Please take this letter from Tommy Waller this past week and lift it up in prayer and intercession:

Dear Friends,

With all the wonderful things that have happened over the last 3 months it was difficult to hear the news on Monday morning, November 15th, that another building freeze is quickly becoming reality here in Jerusalem, Judea, and Samaria. This time for 3 months. It was almost exactly one year ago, after the 2009 harvest, that we got the same news of a 10 month building freeze.

I was actually at the end of my "end of the harvest update letter" when I received the news of the building freeze. The "harvest update letter" is coming and I'm very excited about sharing it with you, but it was hard for me to write about something as wonderful as the harvest with this on my heart and mind.

The Appeal

This is an appeal to all of you who believe the prophetic mandate in Isaiah 62:1 is still the Word of Godthose who believe that God still has his eyes continually on Israel. (Dt 11:12)

The prophets foretold the restoration of Israel - even the angel Gabriel, who stood in the presence of God, declared to Mary, "The Lord God will give Him the throne of His father David and He will reign over the house of Jacob (Israel) forever: his kingdom will never end." (Lk 1:32,33) Peter cries out in Jerusalem at the Temple gate in Acts 3:21 that all the holy prophets declare this restoration. Simeon and Anna, as well as the disciples all longed for the restoration of Israel - Luke 2:25,38; Acts 1:6. Does your faith, your religion, your heart, carry in it the same passion for the literal restoration of Israel as the prophets, the angels, and those who followed the Messiah - those that saw him face to face - those that walked by His side and sat at His feet? The disciples hoped for, longed for, and believed in a kingdom restored to Israel and Yeshua confirmed it in Acts 1:6,7.

Included in this great restoration of Israel - was the re-building of this land. (Isa 61:4; Jer 31:4; Jer 33:7; Eze 36:10,33,36; Amo 9:11; Mt 6:10; Act 15:16) It appears the time has come for the Anna's and the Simeon's to rise up and begin intercession. Let me add that according to the scriptural description of Anna and Simeon you must believe the Messiah's purpose is for the redemption of Jerusalem and the consolation of Israel in which Yeshua and all the holy prophets also agreed. This redemptionthis consolation will impact and is impacting the entire world. (Rm 11:15)

The Nations Rage

The leaders of this world are passionate about the destruction of Israel. They are obsessive in their attempt to stop the prophetic rebuilding. Israel is the only piece of land on earth God considered so precious, so valuable, that He included it, along with His children, in an eternal covenant. It is this covenant that causes the nations to rage. (Ps 2)

On the other hand, in severe contrast, most Bible believing communities of the world are passive concerning the restoration of Israelsome choosing not to talk about it at all or to relegate its discussion to a special event on the church calendar. Thankfully the prosperity teachers have "locked in" on the "give money to those who give money to Israel and you will be blessed" teaching. Without this movement in Christian circles the Jewish people and Israel would, with the exception of us "every word of God is still true" people, be pretty much on their own.

Because of political pressure even the "Israel prosperity" organizations, who once gave millions of dollars to Judea and Samaria, are choosing not to support the heartland because it is seeing that

mainstream public opinion is leaning towards giving up the specific land where God spoke an eternal covenant to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob.

The political pundits are saying that the 3 month freeze will allow more time to discuss the final borders between the over 3000 year old nation of Israel and the new, never existed before, Palestinian state. **What is your position concerning the building freeze?** Are you siding with mainstream opinion or like Peter - with the holy prophets? Your faith - does it line up with Galatians 3:29 and Ephesians 2:12? Are you a stranger to the covenants of Israel? Please consider this - outside of Israel there is no hope and no God. (Eph 2:12) Paul doesn't cut us any slack does he?just tells it like it is.
