Online applications are being accepted until 7:00pm, August 14th, 2011. Before you apply, read this entire email so you are clear about the agreements which are a part of your commitment. As a man applying to staff at this NWTA, you agree to:

- Complete all required paperwork (Medical Form, Release, Ethics Agreement), and submit to the Weekend Coordinator with your staffing fee before the established paperwork deadline. The paperwork deadline will be announced when you are informed that you have been chosen to staff.
- Attend in person or via conference call one pre-weekend staff meeting: Thursday, September 08th at 7:00pm
- Attend in person one pre-weekend staff meeting: Thursday, October 06th at 7:00pm.
- Mentor and stay connected with at least one New Brother during and following the weekend, if so assigned.
- Attend one of the Graduation Ceremonies to be held within 14 days of the NWTA. (This applies only to men who live in Alberta).

Staff Selection Criteria:

1. Priority consideration is given to men who are sponsoring an initiate at the training.
2. Additional consideration is given to men who have previously participated on a 'Men of Service' team.
3. Additional consideration is given to men who are active in an I-Group.
4. BSDT is required prior to a man staffing for the 4th time.
5. The Selection committee will use its best judgment to select a well-balanced staff with the interests and safety of the men being initiated as our highest priority.
