Do not add a video that has already been added by a classmate, so view the ones posted before you add yours. We want a variety not the same video multiple times!!! By the end of the semester we will have quite a nice collection of video resources shared and original videos.

Make sure you include the following information when you post your video:

title of the video

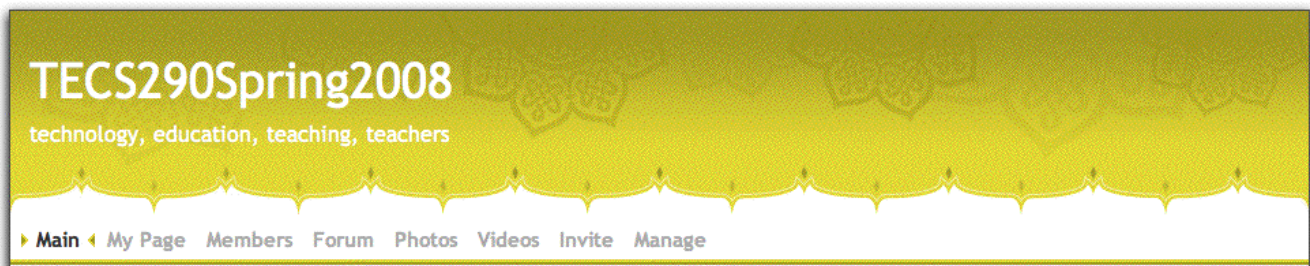
a description (including URL)

the author

where it is from if available (Town, State)

and the actual URL to the original *YouTube* or *TeacherTube* video in the description.

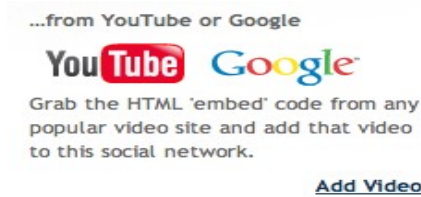
In your description please tell why you selected this video to post. I have posted an example, make sure you watch the whole thing, it is worth your 20+ minutes!!



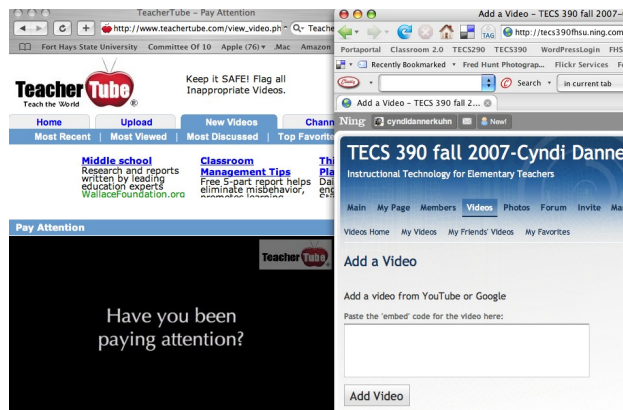
Scroll down and locate the Sir Ken Robinson: *Do Schools Kill Creativity* video in the center column that I shared. I also shared a second one called *Pay Attention*.

Click the **Add Video** button.

Look to the bottom and right of the window and find the *YouTube* and *Google* logos and click the **Add Video** button.



Make sure you have located the video you plan to upload/embed ahead of time. I usually have two browser windows opened so I can jump back and forth.



Find the **Embeddable** code line for *TeacherTube* or the **Embed** code *YouTube* and paste in the window. *TeacherTube* looks like this:

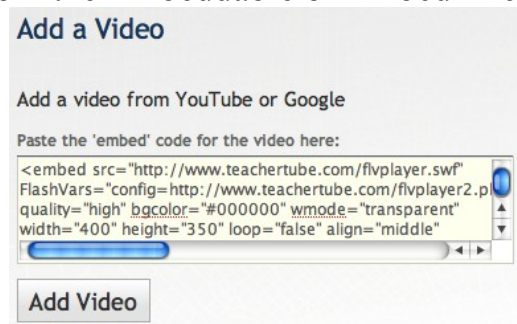
(Put this video on your website. Works on PBwiki, PMwiki, Wikispaces, Friendster, Blogger, MySpace!)

Copy & Paste the code from the Embeddable or Embed line in the window.



Click the **Add Video** button.

The **Edit Video Information** window will now open and you should complete all the fields. Make sure you include the URL of where the video is located in *YouTube* or *TeacherTube* as well as where the video is from and why you choose to share it in our **Classroom 2.0** site.

Click the **Save Changes** button. It will now upload your video to our **Classroom 2.0** site. Depending on the speed of your Internet connection and the length of the video, this process may take a few minutes, so be patient!!

During the next week or so, spend some time viewing the videos your classmates have shared and add your rating and comments to them. I suspect everyone will be entertained and learn a thing or two, so enjoy! remember everything in Classroom 2.0 impacts your grade.
