COURSE

Race starts at 9:00am, with pre-race staging at Village Park in Brown Deer, north of Brown Deer Road and east of 51st St. Both the 5K and 10K courses will be run through residential neighborhoods within Brown Deer. The race starts and ends at the Village Park, 4800 West Green Brook Dr.

RACE DAY

Parking for participants is available in the FIS Parking Lot, best accessed from Arbor Drive. So that everyone may enjoy the event, baby joggers will only be permitted in the walk following all other participants, and pets will not be allowed on the course at all.

PACKET PICK-UP

All race packets should be picked up on race day, 7:30 to 8:30am at the Village Park in the Registration Area.

Restrooms available at the Village Park.

AWARD CEREMONY

Three deep in each age group, male & female, and one male and one female overall winner. Awards Ceremony to be held near Finish Line immediately following the race. All decisions of the Badgerland Striders on that day are final.
