Hard News:

R: Camp Loveway: David Icke talking of his latest book **The Lion Sleeps No More** - the whole story of the Arab spring, and the story of Mubarak and Morsi; spoke of the crystal grid that was activated on Dec 28 and the seed pods with the xenon gas will be found - be careful about folks with the 3rd eye in their forehead - just because we look different does not mean we are not of The Office of the Christ

- About the **Koch Bros in Alabama**: droves of people have died because the water ways are polluted with horrific chemicals and so is the air - they can hire a Brinks truck and deliver bags of \$ and shut their mouths [shite happens and people shut their mouths
- Ref to Exxon Valdez spill, Racion in Indiana which has exposed people to all kinds of chemicals; the fracking and the shale; DARPA; the pharmaceutical corporations and the # of people who die taking them
