

Position: myHCN Web Series Interviewee

Do you remember being an undergrad trying to figure out your post-college job and career path? If you're like most of those who are where you were a year ago, you may recall it can be a confusing process. And that it's hard to figure out where to get the info you need to make some big decisions. These are some of the questions we hear from students getting ready to graduate:

- What can I actually do with my major in my first job out of college?
- What have others done with a similar major and how well do they like it?
- I've heard about job titles but I don't really get what I'd be doing in that type of job on a day to day basis
- I know about a handful of jobs but I've heard there are loads of jobs out there that I could apply for. How do I find out about those?

We're on a mission to help current students demystify this process - and learn from people like you who have been there. So we may need your help.

If you're someone who really likes the work you do - you feel excited about what you're working on, the people you work with, the industry you're in and the work environment you're in, then we would love to talk. Is every day a basket of roses? Likely no - there are likely parts of work that you might enjoy less. But these are the minority of your day. On the whole work is engaging, it's interesting and you feel like you're bringing your best self to work and tapping into your skills and work you enjoy doing.

**List of questions for interviews (requirement: you really like the work you're doing)**

1. What was your major?
2. What is your job title?
3. What did you think your job would entail when you took it?
4. What does that mean you DO during the day? (Describe in detail)
5. What are your values, interests and strengths (*note: this will be based on having gone through the exercises to be provided*) How do they link to your job?
6. What are 3 roles you've interacted with at your company that you weren't aware of before you started?

Here's our ask:

- We'd like to do a brief ~10-15 minute Q&A on video of you, where you'll answer a few questions we'll give you in advance; our focus is on what your major is, what your role is and what that actually means that you DO day to day
- We'll ask you to do three brief exercises that identify your values, interests and strengths - and we'd love to hear how these do or don't play into the work you do
- Lastly, we want to know about some of the jobs that you've come into contact with that you didn't know about before you took the job - all with a goal to help students learn about jobs they didn't even know existed

You have invaluable perspective and experience that others can benefit from. Imagine if you had this when you were making decisions. Will you join us?
