

Commute Trip Reduction Board members

The Commute Trip Reduction (CTR) Board provides policy guidance for the CTR program. It develops, reviews, and approves local, regional and state CTR plans; allocates program funding; and ensures statewide consistency among county and local ordinances. The board is composed of 16 members representing Washington citizens, businesses, state agencies, transit agencies and local jurisdictions. Board members are appointed by the Secretary of Transportation. Each member (excluding state government representatives, whose terms have no end date) serves a four-year term.
