Event : Recreational Paddle from Royal Leamington Spa to Stratford Upon Avon³
Date : Sunday 9th July 2017 **Distance/Grade :** 18 miles, slow moving river (grade 1) with 4 portage-able weirs.
Entry Fee¹ : £10.00 Adults, £5.00 Under 18s². Pay on the day. **Main Risks :** Warwick weir/sluice/waterwheel, 3 other weirs, and deer gates³.
Organiser: Royal Leamington Spa Canoe Club (RLSCC) West Midlands BCU Region. **Start Time:** 9-00 to 10-00am (LATEST!)

NOTES :

- Entry Fee :** 50% of the entry fee for the event will go to The Guide Dogs for the Blind Association. Of the other 50% a portion will be used to cover organising expenses and the remainder will go towards Royal Leamington Spa Canoe Club. All sponsorship money will go directly to the Guide Dogs for the Blind Association. Liability insurance cover is not provided.
- Under 18s :** All paddlers under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian who will be responsible for their conduct and who will sign them in at the beginning of the event.
- Instructions Sheet :** Please study the instructions (available on the website www.doggypaddle.org.uk or at the registration desk) carefully as it provides important safety information and instructions on the main hazards on the route. Marshals will be placed at each weir, and their directions must be followed. Failure to obey these instructions constitutes a safety risk and could jeopardise the future running of the event. All paddlers should be sufficiently fit and competent to complete the 18 mile trip in their chosen craft. Deer gates should be open!
