

Bunchy Noggin Topper

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The easiest-ever way to make a knit hat! This pattern is a no-frills quick knit project- perfect for beginners or anyone who wants to create a quick Noggin Topper!

Materials:

1 size 7 circular needle (12" long)

1 ball Fixation by Cascade

You can substitute any yarn, but may have to adjust the stitch count accordingly. I love Fixation because it's super soft and really stretchy, so the hat will fit just about any size head.

Sizes: Infant, Child, Small, Med/Large

Cast on 60 (70, 80, 90) stitches.

Knit one row.

Join yarn and continue to knit in the round until desired length of hat + 1.5" (1.5", 2.0", 2.0") for topper. Bind off.

Using a separate strand of yarn, tie around the top portion of the hat tightly to create a topper. Tie the yarn strand around several times, ending in a knot. Pull loose strands through the top bunched portion and weave in ends, trimming off excess.
