

Postdoctoral Fellowship in EBD-CSIC Flavivirus transmission network in Doñana
Estacion Biológica de Doñana, Department of Wetland Ecology
We have a position available for a postdoctoral scientist to study a bird-mosquito-Flavivirus transmission network, as part of a project funded by the Andalusian Government. This project addresses Flavivirus transmission in Doñana National Park, by combining data on the spatial and temporal distribution of birds and mosquitoes, feeding preferences of mosquitoes and virus prevalence to model the risk of virus transmission. Applicants should have demonstrated interest in ecology and evolutionary biology, and a PhD in landscape ecology, avian pathology, epidemiology, molecular ecology or related field. Preference will be given to young applicants who have experience with molecular methods and/or landscape modelling or demonstrated potential in these areas.

Review of applicants will begin June 20 and continue until the successful applicant is identified. The starting date is flexible but before the end of January 2010. Applications should include a cover letter with a statement of research interests and timing of availability, a CV, and names and contact information for two professional references.
