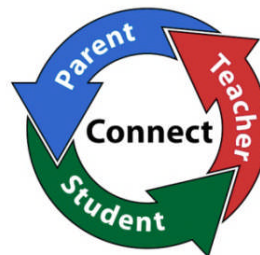

**MEMORY TREASURE:** Psalm 103:1, "Praise the Lord, O my soul."

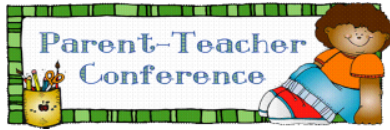
**BOOKS:** *The Lamb and the Butterfly, The Very Quiet Cricket, The World of Ants and Baa Baa Black Sheep*
