

# **2015-2016 Recap of Campaign for People with Intellectual Disabilities (CPID)**

## **2015-2016 was a fantastic year:**

- Total revenue \$674,926.13, a \$41,347.21 increase which is +6.5%, compared to 2014-2015, \$633,578.92.

## **2015 CPID candy expense, \$45,787.95**

The councils with the largest amount collected per member within their divisions were as follows 1-99:

- Council 12448, Akron \$135.53; 100-199,
- Council 1722, Cherokee \$109.52; 200-299,
- Council 888, Ottumwa \$ 52.65; 300-399,
- Council 1466, LeMars \$108.36; 400+,
- Council 532, Davenport \$ 64.89; 207 of 236,
