The East Coast Gang Investigator's Association and its co-host, MAGLOCLLEN, will host the 17th Annual East Coast Gang Investigator's Association Information Sharing Conference at the Atlantic Sands Hotel and Conference Center, 101 North Boardwalk, Rehoboth Beach, Delaware.

The agenda for this information sharing conference will include material from federal, state, and local law enforcement agencies focusing on a wide range of domestic and international gangs and all aspects of their associated activities. Various gangs will be examined with regard to their propensity for violence, involvement in the narcotics trade and use of firearms. All topics are tentatively scheduled and a finalized agenda will be made available in the upcoming months. **THE CONFERENCE IS RESTRICTED TO CRIMINAL JUSTICE PERSONNEL ONLY.** Please be sure to have your criminal justice identification at the time of registration.

The keynote speaker will be **Lt. Col. Dave Grossman**, a former West Point psychology professor, Professor of Military Science, and an Army Ranger, who has combined his experiences to become the founder of a new field of scientific endeavor, which has been termed "killology." He is one of the nation's leading law enforcement trainers.

On Tuesday morning, September 20th, from 8:30 a.m.-11:30 a.m., there will be an optional Gangs 101. Please check the box on the registration form if you are interested in attending this class.

Monday, September 19th, will be a travel day with registration being held from 5:00 pm to 7:00 pm. An additional registration will be held on Tuesday, September 20th beginning at 8:00 am. The conference will commence at 1:00 pm, on Tuesday, September 20th and end on Friday, September 23rd at approximately 1:00 pm.

There is a \$175 registration fee, which includes one breakfast buffet, one luncheon, breaks and conference related materials. A late registration fee of \$25.00 (\$200 Registration Cost) will be assessed after August 19, 2016. **Please make checks payable to ECGIA, federal tax ID# 52-2098813.** Vouchers & credit cards are accepted. An optional fee of \$50 will be collected at registration for those attendees wanting to participate in the information sharing/hospitality on September 20th, 21st, & 22nd. **A full refund will be issued for cancellations received by August 31, 2016. No refunds will be issued after August 31, 2016. Substitutions are permitted at any time prior to the conference.**

Each individual will be responsible for making his/her own reservation no later than Thursday, August 4, 2016. Initial and Renewal training to be held at our

The East Coast Gang Investigator's Association proudly announces its new and revamped Certified Gang Professional Program. The program will be delivered for those wishing to receive certification during the course of our annual conference this September in Rehoboth Beach, Delaware. The blocks of instruction, associated study materials and tests will be delivered during the course of the conference and will require those interested in receiving certification to attend the *Optional* Gangs 101 block on Tuesday, September 20th and a second block later in the week along with the program test.

The fee for this program is \$125.00 for both those seeking their initial certification or a renewal. The association will recognize a renewal period of three (3) years.
