Program/Presentation Module

This multi media presentation will address the violent impact gang culture has created and how the increase of violence is a result of the behaviors and presence that gangs have introduced to communities.

Participants will be educated on the culture of youth gangs, including; why youth join gangs and the proactive measures that can be taken to engage gang involved youth and assist in preventing involvement. This will increase their capacity to create an assessment of their community; along with the youth they serve, by better understanding gang signs and symbols, body markings, graffiti and other indicators involved in the gang culture.

Strategies for combining prevention, intervention and suppression methods will be discussed, and participants will understand how to implement proactive efforts in their community or agency. Community based partnerships will be emphasized along with the roles that schools, faith based organizations, community agencies and law enforcement play.
