CHRISTIAN ALLIES CAUCUS ADDRESSES LARGEST PRO- ISRAEL PASTOR'S CONFERENCE IN INDIA

Mk's meet Christian and political leaders

Jerusalem – February 1. KCAC members MK Fania Kirshenbaum (Israel Beteinu) and MK Yoel Hasson (Kadima), IIACF President Rabbi **Benny Elon**, and KCAC director Josh Reinstein addressed over 1,000 pastors in India. Their visit, which was sponsored by US-based Christian organization Covenant Alliances, was aimed at building relations between Israel and Indian Christian leaders based on mutual **Judeo-Christian** values.

This Indian Pastors conference, which draws pastors from across India, is aimed at educating Indian Christians on Israel and the unique **Judeo-Christian** bond. The group also met with New Delhi based Pastor Mathew Kuruville and various Indian political leaders.

Covenant Alliances is a U.S.-based organization dedicated to fostering improved relations between Christians and Jews. It carries out its goals by hosting conferences and other educational events intended to bring together leading representatives of both groups into collaboration. Thus, new bonds of friendship and understanding are formed anchored upon common **Judeo-Christian** religious and ethical values. The KCAC is a bi-partisan caucus comprised of seventeen Knesset members. Established in 2004 by the late Dr Yuri Shtern, it is today chaired by Knesset Member David Rotem. The caucus aims to forge direct lines of communication between Knesset members and Christian leaders, organizations and political representatives in Israel and around the world.
