- *Must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale
- *Be a enrolled Full-Time as a Junior for the 2010-2011 academic school year
- *Must be majoring in one of the following fields:

 - Biology (includes Molecular Biology)
 - Biochemistry
 - Bioinformatics
 - Bioengineering/Biotechnology
 - Zoology (includes Entomology)
