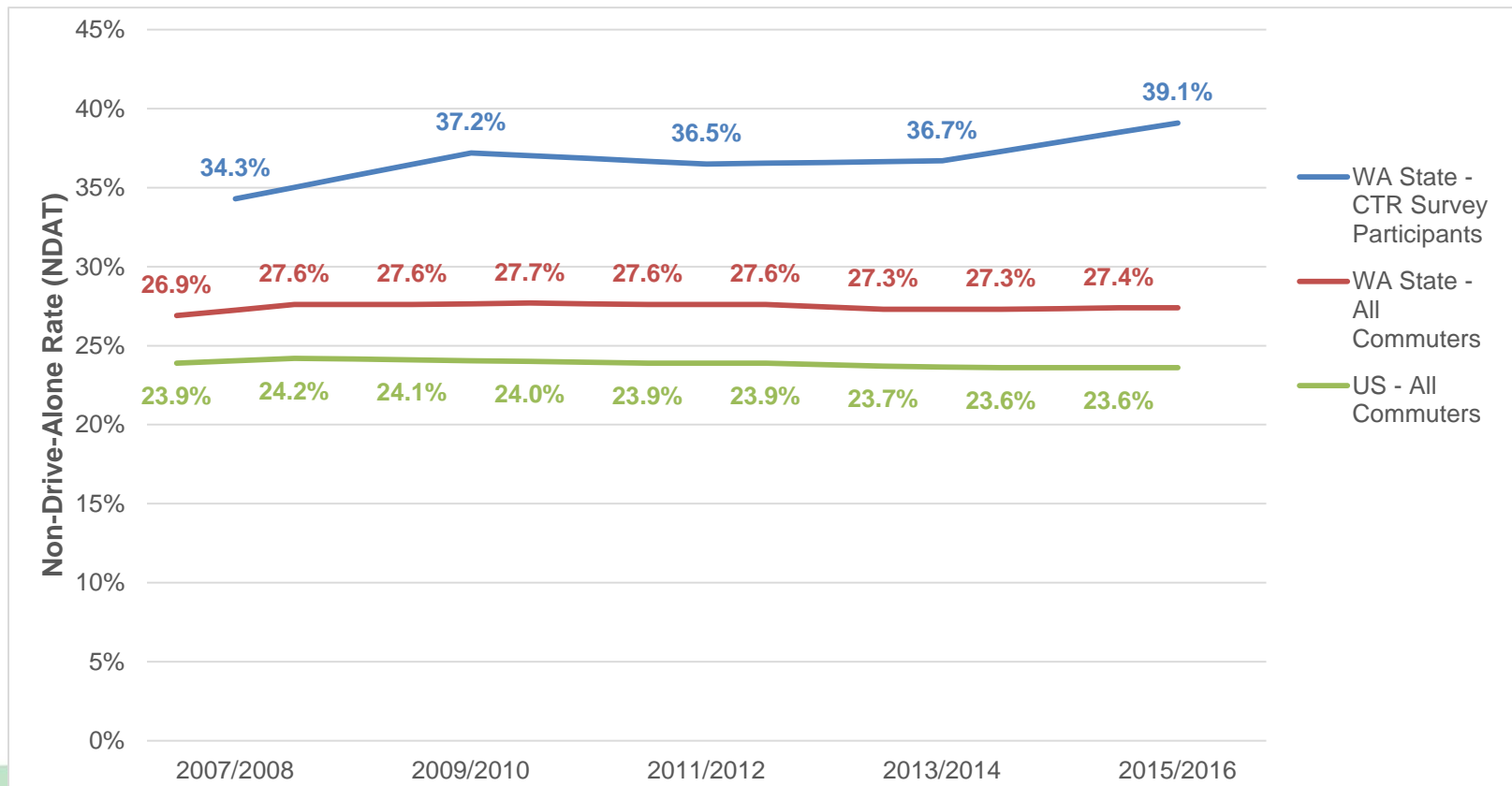

Legislative Report Statistics

DRAFT

- 955 Sites
- NDAT Rate 39.1%, up 4.8% above baseline





Legislative Report Statistics

DRAFT

- Daily VMT 10.1 miles per employee, down 7.42% from baseline
- Daily GHG 18.8 pounds per employee, down 12.9% from baseline
- 79 million fewer miles annually
- 33,473 mTons of CO₂e reduced or 27,664 acres of forest (Walt Disney World)
- Saved \$9.7 million in fuel costs (higher, despite lowering fuel costs)

A line of cars, bumper to bumper, from Seattle to Olympia

- 22,356 fewer daily cars
- 57 miles (from Seattle to Olympia, bumper to bumper)
- \$228m to expand a freeway to accommodate that lane
