The Art Crowd - Youth 48hr art competition

The youth arm of RedArts is holding an art competition. Funding has been made available through the Council's strengthening communities program for The Art Crowd to develop a series of youth-led arts events called Cutting Edge 2014 celebrating young people and creating opportunities to showcase the talents of Redland young artists to the wider community.

As part of Cutting Edge, a 48 hour Art Competition will be held 2nd – 4th May. It is open to ages 13 to 25 years interested in the arts, including film, photography, dance, drama, music and visual arts. Guidelines, terms and conditions for each artistic category will be provided on line at <https://www.facebook.com/48HOURARTCOMP> and entries can be submitted either online or in person. Participating entrants will need to like the art competition page to learn the competition theme as it is only on this page that the theme will be found, and to be in the running for a number of prizes including three \$500 vouchers at a store of their choice.

Entrants will have 48 hours in which to complete a piece of artwork relating to the competition art theme to be released at 6pm on Friday May 2, with the competition ending on Sunday May 4 at 6pm. They will then be allowed a two hour window in which to submit their artworks closing at 8pm. Following judging, winners will be announced at a special youth arts event to be held on Saturday May 31 at RPAC in the Gallery Space. This Cutting Edge Main Event will be a youth Expo and celebration, showcasing the art developed as part of the 48 hour art competition plus providing a platform for the artists to perform live music, exhibit and sell their art works and network.
