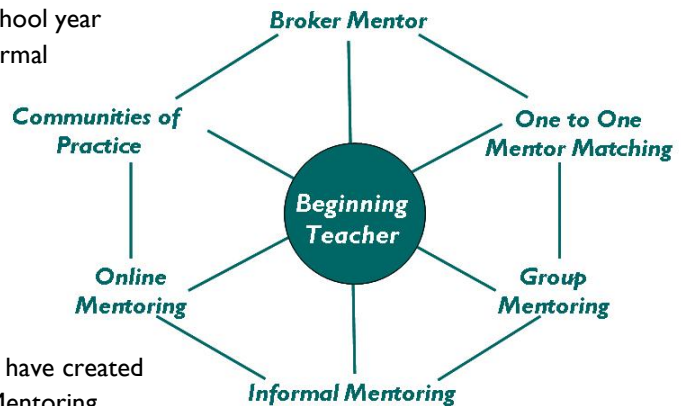


MENTORING MOMENTS: PROFESSIONAL LEARNING RESOURCES FOR MENTORS
