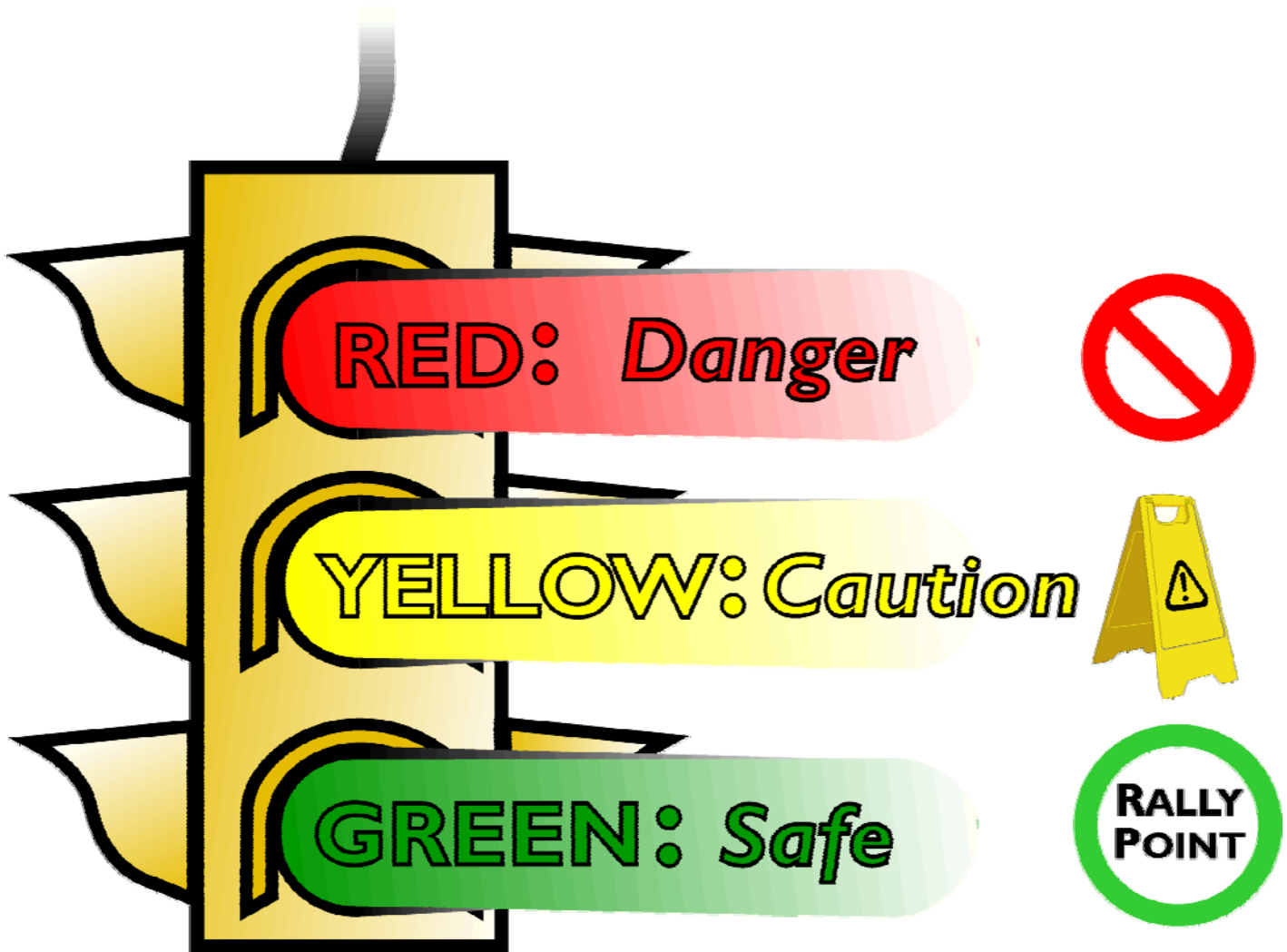


PLEASE READ THIS IMPORTANT INFORMATION!

# COLOR-CODE YOUR SAFETY!



**Use color to make safety more visible, memorable and intuitive:**

→ use colored dots, ribbons, tape, markers, paint, paper, rugs, picture frames, etc. ←

**RED:** to alert people to serious threats. For example: Dangerous chemicals.

**YELLOW:** to urge extra caution and care. For example: slippery/wet floors or steep inclines.

**GREEN:** to remind people of safety-related resources. For example: supplies (food, First Aid kits or defibrillators) or places (Rally Points or safe places to Drop, Cover and Hold On)
