

This document contains information and forms for AFA Year 3 participants who wish to receive 2 hours of graduate credit from the University of Michigan - Dearborn.

THE COURSE IS TITLED : MATH 508AP

PRIME MEMBERS: The 4th session is soon and action needs to be taken if you are electing to earn 2 hours of graduate credit. Participants must indicate that they are committed to receiving credit AND pay their tuition.

IF YOU ARE COMMITTED TO EARNING THE 2 HOURS OF GRADUATE CREDIT:

Make sure you have completed the registration request form posted on the Prime site. You should have already submitted the application for admission form.

- Requirements for 2 Graduate Credit

The graduate credit expectations are the same as for previous AFA offerings.

The Registration Request Form indicates the Course tuition and fees for the graduate credit of \$1,011.40 AND the tuition and fees owed by the Student of \$811.40. *The Center for Mathematics Education provides a stipend of \$200 for each participant who chooses to earn credit.* **Participants should KEEP this form until the fourth session when they will be asked to make a commitment to “take the course for credit;” that is, take responsibility for paying the tuition!**
