- Develop and/or join a Teacher Research Group Grant
- Apply for a Teacher Incentive Grant to support a project in your classroom
- Have the MSUNER as a resource for individual inquiry work
- Engage in action research through an Action Research Team
- Present research projects at the MSUNER Summer Conference
- Work with MSU professors to further their research agendas
