Background

The *International Scientific Conference „Forest Science for a Sustainable Forestry and Human Wellbeing in a Changing World” - INCDS „Marin Drăcea” 85 Years of Activity, Centenary of The Great Union in 1918*” is an open scientific event dedicated to the anniversary of 85 years of activity in forestry research of the National Institute for Research and Development in Forestry „Marin Drăcea”.

In 2018 this great anniversary event coincides with the celebration of 100 years since the Great Union of the Romanian historical provinces.

The conference is focused on forest research, with a large range of topics, including: the impacts of air pollution, climate change, biotic and abiotic stressors on forest resources status, adaptive management, modelling and mapping of forest ecosystems and their services, genetics, protected areas, ecological connectivity, new Earth-Observation technologies applied in forestry field.

Objectives:

1. to increase the visibility of forest science in the global change research policy;
2. to develop the link between forest science and practices in a changing environment and society;
3. to monitor forest health, resources and ecosystem services for a sustainable adaptive management in the context of climate change, atmospheric pollution and other biotic and abiotic stressors;
4. to promote new management concepts, methods and techniques for nature and forest genetic resources conservation.

Topics/Sessions

1. Forest health and climate change impact on forest ecosystems.
2. Forest resources and ecosystems services: modelling and mapping.
3. Nature conservation and forest protected areas in a changing environment and society.
4. Tree breeding and genetic resources for and adaptive forest management to climate change.
5. Forest pests, diseases and their ecological and socio-economic consequences.
6. MONitoring ozone injury to forests for seTTing new critical LEvels.
7. Earth-Observation for forest monitoring and forecasting.

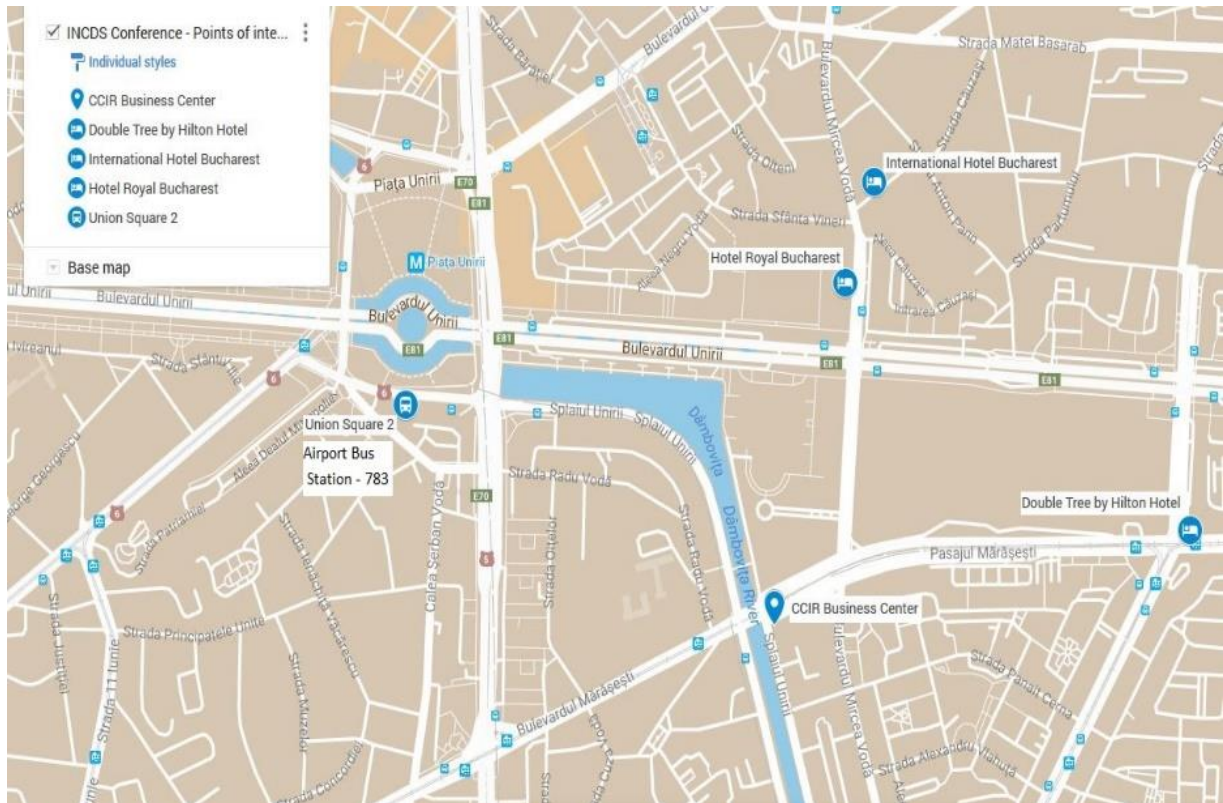

How to reach the conference place (The Chamber of Commerce and Industry of Romania)

By Bus (public transportation)

Take the 783 Express line from Bucharest Henri Coandă International Airport to the city center. The bus stop is in front of the Arrivals Terminal and Departures Terminal. The bus runs every 20 minutes during the day, 40 minutes during the night and it takes 35-45 minutes to get to the city center. The price for one trip is 3,5 lei (about 0.8 €). Tickets can be bought at the card desk in front of the Arrivals Terminal. Make sure your ticket is validated before boarding the bus. The closest bus station to our conference place is **UNION SQUARE 2 (PIATA UNIRII 2)**.

By Taxi

Licensed taxis will be available for passengers arriving at Bucharest “Henri Coandă” International Airport. At the Arrivals Hall there is a yellow MACHINE (touchpoint) called Clever Taxi where you can choose the taxi company and price per km you want to pay. You will find taxis from 1,39lei/km - 3,50lei/km.

The machine will print you out a ticket giving a waiting time and a number (the plate number of the car); this number will be on the side of the taxi which arrives for you, just wait outside for it and show the ticket to the driver.
