**Terri Brooks** – Recently retired from 31 years of teaching in the Conway, NH school system. Terri works primarily in watercolor, painting people doing the activities that make life enjoyable. Her work is about the effects that light and atmosphere have on people and places. Terri is a signature member of the New England Watercolor Society and the Northeast Watercolor Society. She has won many awards locally, regionally, and nationally.

**Stephanie Demme** - Studied at the Pratt Institute, F.I.T. and the Ridgewood School of Art in the areas of design, photography, art and costume history and graphic arts. 15 years in advertising photography led to Stephanie being awarded the Art Directions Award for Calendar Design in 1987.
