



Sign up: Riders receive sign up form at front gate. Riders must take sign up form to top of hill to sign up trailer to receive race number to be entered in race. You will receive two (2) number stickers. One for your front number plate, and one to be put on your full face helmet on the BACK side. Minor riders MUST bring parent/legal guardian to sign up.

Jumping: All slower riders stay to the right, Faster rider intending to double or triple stay on the left. The beginner and novice first big bike group there will be No Jumping the tower Jump.

Entrance to Staging: area is marked by a small American flag.

NO PIT RIDING: The only time your bike/quad is moving is to and from staging area to your pit, or if you are going to your race. First gear only.

Pit Area/Staging Area: Marked by yellow flag with blue diagonal stripe. This is where you bring your gas cans, stands, water/Gatorade for the rider. This is where team riders switch on and off. This is also the area where the race is started. This area is for pit crew ONLY. NO spectators.

Teams: Both riders must report to start area. You decide who is going to start your race. You will then be instructed to where you will switch riders.

NO ONE IS ALLOWED ON COURSE AT ANY TIME!!! STAY BEHIND SPECTATOR FENCING!!!

Concession stand is located at the top of the hill.

Garbage policy: Carry in Carry out. Please clean your pit area before you leave.

Area 51 Motocross Grand Prix (GP) Race

Similar to a Hare Scramble

A GP race is targeted at all levels and types of riding. The GP Race is an event designed to test the overall skills of its riders. One lap around the GP course will consist of riding on the Area 51 Motocross big and intermediate Motocross Tracks, along with the addition of our grass track, a woods loop consisting of many open 4-wheeler wide trails, (bark busters not necessary). The intent is to challenge both the woods and MX riders with racing they are both familiar with and less familiar. Another unique aspect is that for the **big bike classes** and **QUAD classes** you can Team with a friend or ride solo. The intent is to get together with friends who may or may not race regularly or team with different skilled riders such as a woods and mx rider teaming together and have some great fun riding. You may share a bike or each rider can use his own.

The Area 51 Motocross GP Race will be run in four segments: Trophy Payback 1for 3 up to 10th place. Expert payout 100%

Note You Must bring the signup sheet you received at front gate to top of the hill to sign up trailer to receive racer number stickers.
