Israel is God chosen nation.

 Gospel and this actually became an opportunity for the Gentiles to believe in Jesus Christ.

Throughout this process, however, God has never forgotten his Israel. Through prophets, God promised that he will
 make sons of Israel return to their own land. This word of promise by God was finally fulfilled in 1948 when they
 returned to their land and established own country as nation of Israel.

The nation living without their country for past two thousand years returning home and reestablishing a country was
 more miraculous than the Red Sea split and a falling of the Jericho walls. All the nations around the world witnessing
 their journey back to home were just amazed.

Unfortunately even after this miracle they still rejected Jesus. Back in 1948, there were less than thirty Jews who
 believed in Jesus Christ.

Those who believe in Jesus Christ as their Messiah among the Jews are called "Messianic Jew" or "Believer."

The major reason why the number of Messianic Jew couldn't have become greater but small in the land of Israel was
 because of their deep grief of being persecuted on account of crucifying Jesus on the cross. Also in the mind of Jew
 there was a religious belief that God cannot be compared to or equally treated to anyone else but himself. Therefore
 treating Jesus, born in the flesh, equivalent to God was same as idolatry to the Jews.

For this reason, they still can't accept Jesus Christ as the Messiah and as the son of God. .
 Nevertheless, the number of Messianic Jew in Israel increased to three hundred in 1970 and today, sixty years after,
 the number of Messianic Jew increased approximately to 10,000 -14,000. Also Messianic Jew gathering increased to
 hundred as well.

Things which seemed just so impossible are actually happening today in Israel.
 The number of Messianic Jew is increasing! What is this change signifying to us in
 regard of God's timing?
