### SCD 2017 ATLANTA SCHOLARSHIPS

Three types of scholarships will be available to participants of SCD 2017 Atlanta. When you apply, choose the scholarship that fits your situation best. Applicants can apply for only one of these choices.

- 1. Racial Ethic Scholarships from Global Ministries**
- 2. Small Church Scholarship from Global Ministries for churches with under 150 in average worship**
- 3. Southeastern Jurisdiction scholarships:**
  - Southeastern Jurisdiction scholarships for pastors who have less than ten years in service who have under 300 in worship.
  - Southeastern Jurisdiction scholarships for laity who are members of a church with under 300 in worship
  - Clergy serving in a ministry less than 10 years old. Clergy are encouraged to bring one lay member.

If you are applying for a scholarship, please do **not** register until your application has been approved by Global Ministries or SEJ (you will receive an email notifying you if your application has been approved). Also, please wait until you have been accepted before you make a reservation at the scholarship hotel.

Once your scholarship application has been approved, you must **register online** under the category **"SCD Scholarship"** and **pay \$50 for the reduced registration fee.**
