- worst abuse is in the area of tipped employees – every time the minimum wage is raised, the tipped allowance is raised, so the employees never get ahead: within the concept of minimum wage there is the idea that if you earn tips, you only get so much as a minimum wage; the bill they are looking at substantially raises the minimum wage for tipped employees.

The Week in Review Friday, March 14, 2014

A spunky family physician from Canada was the [star witness](#) at a Tuesday hearing about how other countries provide health care at less cost and get better outcomes than the United States. Sen. Bernie Sanders chaired the hearing. The White House would be required to submit a plan for reducing childhood poverty in the U.S. under a Sanders provision added to a bill that passed the Senate on Thursday. President Obama set the gears

in place for millions more workers to get overtime pay. And senators began the week by keeping the Senate in session for an all-night talk-a-thon on global warming.

Health Care Experts from around the world testified on Tuesday about health care systems in Canada, France, Denmark and Taiwan that are more effective and efficient than the United States' model. At a hearing chaired by Sanders, Dr. Danielle Martin, a physician from Toronto, sparred with Sen. Richard Burr. And in what Canada's CBC News called "some political theatre," Sanders asked if Canada's current prime minister is a socialist. "No sir, our prime minister is quite conservative," Dr. Martin said. "So obviously," Sanders said tongue in cheek, "as a conservative he wants to implement the American health-care system. I gather that is the first thing he did when he took power, is that right?" the senator continued. "Not exactly," the Toronto physician replied. "Support for single-payer Medicare in Canada goes across all political stripes." [Watch highlights](#)

Childhood Poverty The Senate on Thursday voted to renew programs providing health care and food assistance to children. The measure includes Sanders' provision calling on the White House to submit a five-year plan to reduce the childhood poverty rate in the United States. "Unfortunately, despite our great wealth, more of our citizens are living in poverty than ever before and we have the highest rate of childhood poverty of any major country in the industrialized world," Sanders said. The bill now goes to the House of Representatives, [Watch the speech](#)

Overtime Pay President Obama ordered the Labor Department on Thursday to revise federal rules on overtime pay to make millions more workers eligible for extra pay when they work more than 40 hours a week. Sanders said he hopes the overtime threshold, now \$455 a week, will be updated to at least account for inflation and cover workers making less than \$1,000 per week. Sanders said the move by the president is part of a welcome shift in focus by the White House to address the nation's most pressing problem – high levels of income and wealth inequality.

Long-Term Jobless Unemployment benefits would be restored for those without jobs for six months or more under an agreement that a rump group of five Senate Republicans reached with agreed on Thursday to vote. Under the deal, the handful of Republican senators would join with the 55 Senate Democrats and independents to renew the benefits and give retroactive assistance to more than 2 million Americans whose benefits expired late last year. The legislation could pass the Senate in late March, but its fate in the Republican-controlled House of Representatives was unclear. Speaker John Boehner has opposed other Senate plans to help the unemployed.

CIA Torture Cover-Up Sen. Dianne Feinstein, the Senate Intelligence Committee, on Tuesday accused the Central Intelligence Agency of spying on congressional staffers as they investigated the agency's illegal detention and interrogation programs under President George W. Bush. To Sanders, the revelation was "another sign that our intelligence community is out of control and that there must be greater oversight by Congress." Earlier this year, in response to a question from Sanders, the National Security Agency did not expressly deny spying on Congress.

Global Warming All-Nighter In a dramatic gesture calling for action on climate change, Sanders was among some two dozen senators who staged an all-night Senate session from Monday night through Tuesday morning. "What we're trying to do is to make the American people aware that the debate about climate change really is over, that the scientific community is virtually unanimous in agreeing that climate change is real, that it is caused by human activity, that it is already causing devastating problems in the United States and around the world," Sanders said. He also discussed legislation he introduced with Sen. Barbara Boxer, the environment committee chairman, to tax the carbon and methane emissions that cause global warming. It's been called the "gold standard" of climate legislation.

Koch Brothers Exposed Sanders welcomed Majority Leader Harry Reid's effort to expose the influence of

Charles and David Koch, the billionaire brothers who have bankrolled Republican candidates and conservative causes. The brothers want to [abolish Social Security](#), [eliminate minimum wage laws](#), [block emergency unemployment benefits](#), [put private insurance companies back in charge of your health care](#), and [give even more tax breaks for themselves](#).

[What Danielle Martin's takedown of a GOP Senator tells us about our simplistic North American health care debate](#)

The testy exchange on Tuesday between an anti-Obamacare U.S. Senator and a Canadian doctor at a subcommittee hearing in Washington D.C. made for great political theatre. But the confrontation also shows why the debate about health country — in both countries — can be a dialogue of the death.

A Toronto doctor snidely held her own Tuesday after an obscure U.S. Senate subcommittee hearing suddenly turned into a quarrel over the purported deadliness of Canadian health care.

"On average, how many Canadian patients on a waiting list die each year? Do you know?" Republican Senator Richard Burr asked at the end of a prickly exchange with Dr. Danielle Martin, vice president of Medical Affairs at Toronto's Women's College Hospital.

"I don't, sir, but I know that there are 45,000 in America who die waiting because they don't have insurance at all," she said.

The forum was the [Subcommittee on Primary Health and Aging](#), where experts from Taiwan, Denmark, France and Canada had been summoned to deliver defences of single-payer healthcare systems.

An hour into the hearing, Sen. Burr, an anti-Obamacare senator from North Carolina, zeroed in on the Canadian representative, Dr. Martin, to ask "why are doctors exiting the public system in Canada?"

After first apologizing that she had not made herself "understood" in her prepared testimony, she replied "there are no doctors exiting the public system in Canada, and in fact we see a net influx of physicians from the United States into the Canadian system over the last number of years.

Unperturbed, Mr. Burr smiled and followed up with the question "what do you say to an elected official who goes to Florida and not the Canadian system to have a heart valve replacement?"

The reference was to Newfoundland Premier Danny Williams' controversial 2010 decision to undergo heart surgery at a Miami hospital.

"It's actually interesting," replied Dr. Martin, "because in fact the people who are the pioneers of that particular surgery ... are in Toronto, at the Peter Munk Cardiac Center, just down the street from where I work."

She then hinted that Mr. Williams was of the mistaken belief that simply paying more for something "necessarily makes it better."

The senator shot back that Americans like their healthcare because they "judge quality and they judge innovation," not because they pay more.

2014, Mar 12 Feinstein goes after CIA attempt to put the blame on Congress

California Democratic Sen. Dianne Feinstein [took to the Senate floor](#) this week to accuse the CIA of violating the law and the Constitution by spying on Senate staffers investigating the agency's Bush-era torture program. But the CIA's alleged search of senate intelligence committee computers wasn't the only thing that prompted her to speak out. It was accusations by a high-ranking CIA official that it was Senate staff who had broken the law.

"I felt that I needed to come to the floor today, to correct the public record and to give the American people the facts about what the dedicated committee staff have been working so hard for, Feinstein said, over the "last several years as part of the committee's investigation."

In 2009, the Senate intelligence committee began an investigation into the agency's rendition and interrogation program during the Bush administration. The CIA set up a secure workplace for the committee where they would be able to access classified documents provided by the agency, with computers segregated from the main CIA network. According to Feinstein, the CIA and the committee had agreed upon ground rules, which included a commitment by the CIA not to interfere with the committee's inquiry. Only CIA IT staff were supposed to be given access to the committee's computers.

CIA spying allegations causes a stir

Shortly after the news broke that the CIA may have searched those computers, a [counter-accusation](#) began [surfacing](#) in the press: That it was Senate intelligence committee staff who had acted improperly by gaining access to documents they weren't supposed to have. All of a sudden, it was the intelligence committee staff who were facing accusations of wrongdoing, for [supposedly having](#) "walked out of one of the spy agency's top-secret facility with classified documents that the CIA contended they weren't authorized to have."

According to Feinstein, it was one of the CIA's top lawyers, Robert EATINGER, [who asked the Department of Justice](#) to look into whether Senate staff had broken the law. The CIA Inspector General has also asked the Justice Department to look into the CIA's conduct.

CIA Director John Brennan, responding to criticism from senators over his agency's alleged spying on Senate staffers, made a point of stating that "the appropriate authorities reviewing this matter will determine where

wrongdoing, if any, occurred in either the executive branch or legislative branch.” Brennan has denied “spying” on the committee, but this may be a matter of semantics, as Brennan may simply believe that the CIA’s alleged search of the committee’s [computers was legitimate or justified](#).

Feinstein called EATINGER’s referral “a potential effort to intimidate this staff.” According to Feinstein, EATINGER is mentioned several times in the committee’s yet to be declassified report.

EATINGER is the same CIA attorney who [blessed the destruction of video tapes](#) depicting the torture of suspected terror detainees. Senate staff had every reason to believe history might repeat itself, and that the Agency might seek to destroy materials considered damning.

“Senators and congressmen received their right to access executive branch information from the American people when they were elected,” said Vicki Divoll, an attorney who has worked both for the CIA and the Senate intelligence committee. “We gave them the power to access information at the CIA on our behalf, to keep watch on the agency for us. If Congress can’t do it, no one can.”

While operational details may be kept from the intelligence committee as a matter of policy, according to Divoll, under the law the Senate intelligence committee is entitled to see every document the agency has.

“The Senate intelligence Committee, under current interpretations of its Constitutional powers, is entitled to every document in the CIA’s possession,” said Divoll. “The documents themselves, however acquired, and whatever their classification level, may be reviewed by Senate staff in the performance of their legislative tasks.”

Feinstein alluded to this in her speech.

“Some of the Internal Panetta Review documents—some—contained markings indicating that they were “deliberative” and/or “privileged.” Feinstein said. “Congress does not recognize these claims of privilege when it comes to documents provided to Congress for our oversight duties.”

In other words, the CIA doesn’t get to keep secrets from the intelligence committee unless the committee allows them to.

“The CIA, and most agencies of the executive branch, frequently reference a vague bundle of privileges – executive, deliberative, attorney-client – to support the claim that they can keep information from Congress,” Divoll says. “Neither the Supreme Court, nor any lower court, has ever found that any such privilege exists.”

The intelligence committee staff participating in the investigation, Divoll said, would have the same clearances as the staff at the CIA. And according to Feinstein, the CIA had removed documents given to the committee at least twice in 2010 and later apologized. In January 2014, Feinstein says Brennan himself informed the committee in that the computers Senate staff were using had been “searched.”

A key item at issue is an internal CIA document, referred to by Feinstein as the “Panetta review,” which refers to former CIA Director Leon Panetta. Democratic senators on the committee believe the Panetta review contradicts the CIA’s rebuttal of conclusions reached by the committee’s report on Bush-era torture. The intelligence committee’s report is said to be highly critical of the Bush torture program, whose operations Feinstein said were “far different and far more harsh than the way the CIA had described them to us.” President Obama declined to weigh in but told reporters Wednesday that he was still committed to declassifying the Senate report’s findings.

According to Feinstein, the Panetta review, which was among the more than six million CIA documents provided to the committee for its investigation, was removed from the computers on the intelligence committee’s workspace sometime after the CIA discovered Senate staffers had gotten access to it. But there’s nothing sinister about cleared committee staff transporting secret documents from one secure place to another.

“There’s not a security risk that they have it in the Senate, staff is regularly provided with the means by which

they can carry information from place to place,” says Mieke Eoyang, a former Senate intelligence committee staffer who now works as a national security analyst at Third Way. “They were writing up a report on said documents, which was the whole point of the investigation.”

In the meantime, the CIA is still refusing to turn over the Panetta review, even though the committee has already seen it. “There is no basis in law for the CIA to keep such a document from the committee,” says Divoll. “No privilege exists to justify keeping that document from Congress.”

Senate staff removing copies of the documents [may have violated the ground rules](#) agreed to by the intelligence committee and the CIA. But even if it was a violation—and Feinstein says it wasn’t—that’s not the same as breaking the law. And according to Feinstein, the CIA’s search of the intelligence committee’s computers was worse than a simple breach of the ground rules—it was a violation of the law, the U.S. Constitution, and crucially, a threat to the entire oversight structure set up to monitor the massive American national security state.

The full details aren’t known yet – it’s possible that the way that the Senate staffers acquired the documents was inappropriate. Feinstein insists that’s not true, and the Panetta Review was among the millions turned over to the committee for their investigation. Eoyang said that the possibility that Senate staffers somehow hacked into the CIA’s network and stole documents – material they were legally entitled to see anyway – is far-fetched.

“They’re policy people, not hackers, that’s not what they do,” Eoyang said. “The suggestion that there’s wrongdoing on behalf of the staff here, seems to be pretty weak sauce.”

Senate Intelligence Committee Chair Dianne Feinstein accused the CIA on Tuesday of violating the law and the Constitution of the United States by interfering in a committee investigation into Bush-era torture of terror suspects.

Brennan: CIA was in no way spying

Feinstein said the CIA had removed documents provided to the committee through a special, segregated network set up by the agency for the committee to pursue its investigation. Among the documents removed was an internal review of CIA interrogation techniques conducted by then-CIA Director Leon Panetta, which committee members have said corroborated committee findings critical of the agency's interrogation program. In an interview with msnbc later Tuesday morning, CIA Director John Brennan disputed Feinstein's allegations.

"The CIA just went and searched the committee's computers," Feinstein said on the Senate floor. Feinstein said that when it was discovered the documents were removed, the CIA initially blamed its IT staff, then said the documents were removed at the request of the White House. Feinstein said the White House denied doing so.

"This was done without the knowledge or approval of committee members or staff, and in violation of our written agreements. Further, this type of behavior would not have been possible had the CIA allowed the committee to conduct the review of documents here in the Senate," Feinstein said. "In short, this was the exact sort of CIA interference in our investigation that we sought to avoid at the outset."

Feinstein said that the CIA's activities may have violated the Fourth Amendment, the Computer Fraud and Abuse Act, and executive order 12333, which bars the CIA from conducting domestic surveillance. Feinstein also said the CIA's activities violated the separation of powers principles in the Constitution by interfering with congressional oversight of the executive branch. The CIA's inspector general had referred the matter to the Justice Department, Feinstein, a Democrat from California, said.

Did CIA search senate committee's computers?

Senate Majority Leader Harry Reid said he "unequivocally" supported Feinstein and called on the CIA to apologize. But several Democrats with whom Feinstein has butted heads while defending the intelligence community also backed her up.

Vermont Democratic Sen. Patrick Leahy, who chairs the judiciary committee, said shortly after Feinstein's speech that "I cannot think of any speech by any member of either party as important as the one the senator from California just gave." Oregon Democratic Sen. Ron Wyden said in a statement that he would "continue to support Chairman Feinstein's efforts to get more answers and accountability from the CIA about this search."

Although Senate Minority Leader Mitch McConnell declined to comment, other Republican senators weighed in on Feinstein's side. Arizona Republican Sen. John McCain, who has criticized Brennan in the past, [called Feinstein's allegations](#) "very disturbing" and said "we may need some kind of independent investigation."

That Feinstein has long been seen as a reliable defender of the intelligence community made her allegations all the more shocking to experts and longtime observers.

"What is striking is not only the allegations themselves, but the fact that they are coming from Sen. Feinstein, who in other contexts has been such an outspoken champion of the intelligence community," said Steven Aftergood, director of the Federation of American Scientists Project on Government Secrecy. "The possibility of

CIA interference in congressional deliberations is shocking, and it may represent a historical crisis in intelligence oversight.”

The committee and the CIA have been at odds over the public release of a committee report on CIA interrogations that took place during the presidency of George W. Bush. The report is said to be harsh in its evaluation of the agency. That dispute broke out into the open last week, when [McClatchy](#) and the [New York Times](#) reported that the Department of Justice was looking into whether the CIA improperly accessed the committee’s computers, and whether the committee came into possession of documents it wasn’t supposed to have. The clash between the committee and the CIA is one of the most serious since the intelligence committees were established in the 1970s to oversee the intelligence community.

“This a fundamental breach of the oversight relationship between Congress and the intelligence community,” Mieke Eoyang, a former Senate Intelligence Committee staffer and current national security analyst at Third Way, said of Feinstein’s allegations. “It’s a violation of the CIA’s restriction from operating against American citizens; it’s a violation of separation of powers; it’s a violation of the legislative branch privilege.”

Feinstein said that releasing the report publicly was critical to ensuring that “an un-American and brutal program of detention and interrogation” will “never again be considered and permitted.” Feinstein said the CIA’s accusation that committee staff had somehow “hacked” into the CIA’s network were baseless and an attempt to intimidate the committee into abandoning its quest to release a version of the report to the public.

CIA Director John Brennan, who was a senior leader at the agency during the interrogation programs, pushed back against the Feinstein’s accusations later Tuesday morning during an interview with msnbc’s Andrea Mitchell.

“We are not in any way shape or form” trying to “thwart” the report’s release, Brennan said. The CIA “was in no way was spying on the” committee “or the Senate.”

“Nothing could be further from the truth,” Brennan said to Mitchell, in response to whether the CIA had improperly breached the intelligence committee’s segregated computer network. “We wouldn’t do that. That’s beyond the scope of reason.”

Brennan’s response to Feinstein was muted compared to last week, when he said in a statement he was “deeply dismayed that some members of the Senate have decided to make spurious allegations about CIA actions that are wholly unsupported by the facts.” In an implicit criticism of intelligence committee members, Brennan said, “I would encourage others to refrain from outbursts that do a disservice to the important relationship that needs to be maintained between intelligence officials and Congressional overseers.”

Asked by Mitchell whether he would step down if Feinstein’s accusations turned out to be true, Brennan chuckled but later said President Obama was “the one who can ask me to stay or to go.”

Paul Pillar, a former CIA official who is now a professor at Georgetown University, said the deteriorating relationship between the agency and the intelligence committee would harm oversight. “There could be posturing on the congressional side for the sake of looking like a hard-nosed adversarial overseer, which might not be in the national interest,” Pillar said. “In response to that you might have more defensiveness on the part of the agencies in terms of being willing to share stuff and cooperate.”

But Aftergood said that the conflict might have “positive consequences.”

“It may finally lead to the belated declassification and public release of the committee report on CIA interrogation practices,” Aftergood said. “Beyond that, this episode may ‘stiffen the spine’ of congressional overseers and help to promote a more skeptical, independent and critical approach to the task of intelligence oversight.”

Feinstein said Tuesday that the resolution of the conflict between the agency and the committee would show whether the committee itself was capable of overseeing the intelligence community.

“How this is resolved will show whether the intelligence committee can be effective in monitoring and investigating our nation’s intelligence activities,” said Feinstein, “or whether our work can be thwarted by those we oversee.”

The most prescient portrait of the American character and our ultimate fate as a species is found in Herman Melville's "Moby Dick." Melville makes our murderous obsessions, our hubris, violent impulses, moral weakness and inevitable self-destruction visible in his chronicle of a whaling voyage. He is our foremost oracle. He is to us what William Shakespeare was to Elizabethan England or Fyodor Dostoyevsky to czarist Russia.

Our country is given shape in the form of the ship, the Pequod, named after the [Indian tribe exterminated](#) in 1638 by the Puritans and their Native American allies. The ship's 30-man crew—there were 30 states in the Union when Melville wrote the novel—is a mixture of races and creeds. The object of the hunt is a massive white whale, Moby Dick, which, in a previous encounter, maimed the ship's captain, Ahab, by biting off one of his legs. The self-destructive fury of the quest, much like that of the one we are on, assures the Pequod's destruction. And those on the ship, on some level, know they are doomed—just as many of us know that a consumer culture based on corporate profit, limitless exploitation and the continued extraction of fossil fuels is doomed.

"If I had been downright honest with myself," Ishmael admits, "I would have seen very plainly in my heart that I did but half fancy being committed this way to so long a voyage, without once laying my eyes on the man who was to be the absolute dictator of it, so soon as the ship sailed out upon the open sea. But when a man suspects any wrong, it sometimes happens that if he be already involved in the matter, he insensibly strives to cover up his suspicions even from himself. And much this way it was with me. I said nothing, and tried to think nothing."

We, like Ahab and his crew, rationalize madness. All calls for prudence, for halting the march toward environmental catastrophe, for sane limits on carbon emissions, are ignored or ridiculed. Even with the flashing red lights before us, the increased droughts, rapid melting of glaciers and Arctic ice, monster tornadoes, vast hurricanes, crop failures, floods, raging wildfires and soaring temperatures, we bow slavishly before hedonism and greed and the enticing illusion of limitless power, intelligence and prowess. We believe in the eternal wellspring of material progress. We are our own idols. Nothing will halt our voyage; it seems to us to have been decreed by natural law. "The path to my fixed purpose is laid with iron rails, whereon my soul is grooved to run," Ahab declares. We have surrendered our lives to corporate forces that ultimately serve systems of death. Microbes will inherit the earth.

In our decline, hatred becomes our primary lust, our highest form of patriotism and a form of eroticism. We are made supine by hatred and fear. We deploy vast resources to hunt down jihadists and terrorists, real and phantom. We destroy our civil society in the name of a war on terror. We persecute those, from Julian Assange to Bradley Manning to Edward Snowden, who expose the dark machinations of power. We believe, because we have externalized evil, that we can purify the earth. We are blind to the evil within us. Melville's description of Ahab is a description of the bankers, corporate boards, politicians, television personalities and generals who through the power of propaganda fill our heads with seductive images of glory and lust for wealth and power. We are consumed with self-induced obsessions that spur us toward self-annihilation.

After the attacks of 9/11, [Edward Said](#) saw the parallel with "Moby Dick" and wrote in the London newspaper The Observer:

Osama bin Laden's name and face have become so numbingly familiar to Americans as in effect to obliterate any history he and his shadowy followers might have had before they became stock symbols of everything loathsome and hateful to the collective imagination. Inevitably, then, collective passions are being funneled into a drive for war that uncannily resembles Captain Ahab in pursuit of Moby Dick, rather than what is going on, an imperial power injured for the first time, pursuing its interests systematically in what has become a suddenly reconfigured geography of conflict.

Ahab, as the historian Richard Slotkin points out in his book “Regeneration Through Violence,” is “the true American hero, worthy to be captain of a ship whose ‘wood could only be American.’ ” Melville offers us a vision, one that D.H. Lawrence later understood, of the inevitable fatality of white civilization brought about by our ceaseless lust for material progress, imperial expansion, white supremacy and exploitation of nature.

Melville, who had been a sailor on clipper ships and whalers, was keenly aware that the wealth of industrialized societies came from the exploited of the earth. “Yes; all these brave houses and flowery gardens came from the Atlantic, Pacific and Indian oceans,” Ishmael says of New England’s prosperity. “One and all, they were harpooned and dragged up hither from the bottom of the sea.” All the authority figures on the ship are white men—Ahab, Starbuck, Flask and Stubb. The hard, dirty work, from harpooning to gutting the carcasses of the whales, is the task of the poor, mostly men of color.

Ahab, when he first appears on the quarterdeck after being in his cabin for the first few days of the voyage, holds up a doubloon, an extravagant gold coin, and promises it to the crew member who first spots the white whale. He knows that “the permanent constitutional condition of the manufactured man ... is sordidness.” And he plays to this sordidness. The whale becomes a commodity, a source of personal profit. A murderous greed, one that Starbuck denounces as “blasphemous,” grips the crew. Ahab’s obsession infects the ship.

“I see in him [Moby Dick] outrageous strength, with an inscrutable malice sinewing it,” Ahab tells Starbuck. “That inscrutable thing is chiefly what I hate; and be the white whale agent, or be the white whale principal, I will wreak that hate upon him. Talk not to me of blasphemy, man; I’d strike the sun if it insulted me.”

Ahab conducts a dark Mass, a Eucharist of violence and blood, on the deck with the crew. He orders the men to circle around him. He makes them drink from a flagon that is passed from man to man, filled with draughts “hot as Satan’s hoof.” Ahab tells the harpooners to cross their lances before him. The captain grasps the harpoons and anoints the ships’ harpooners—Queequeg, Tashtego and Daggoo—his “three pagan kinsmen.” He orders them to detach the iron sections of their harpoons and fills the sockets “with the fiery waters from the pewter.” “Drink, ye harpooners! Drink and swear, ye men that man the deathful whaleboat’s bow—Death to Moby Dick! God hunt us all, if we do not hunt Moby Dick to his death!” And with the crew bonded to him in his infernal quest he knows that Starbuck is helpless “amid the general hurricane.” “Starbuck now is mine,” Ahab says, “cannot oppose me now, without rebellion.” “The honest eye of Starbuck,” Melville writes, “fell downright.”

The ship, described by Melville as a hearse, was painted black. It was adorned with gruesome trophies of the hunt, festooned with the huge teeth and bones of sperm whales. It was, Melville writes, a “cannibal of a craft, tricking herself forth in the chased bones of her enemies.” The fires used to melt the whale blubber at night turned the Pequod into a “red hell.” Our own raging fires, leaping up from our oil refineries and the explosions of our ordinance across the Middle East, bespeak our Stygian heart. And in our mad pursuit we ignore the suffering of others, just as Ahab does when he refuses to help the captain of a passing ship who is frantically searching for his son who has fallen overboard.

Ahab is described by Melville’s biographer Andrew Delbanco as “a suicidal charismatic who denounced as a blasphemer anyone who would deflect him from his purpose—an invention that shows no sign of becoming obsolete anytime soon.” Ahab has not only the heated rhetoric of persuasion; he is master of a terrifying internal security force on the ship, the five “dusky phantoms that seemed fresh formed out of air.” Ahab’s secret, private whale boat crew, which has a feral lust for blood, keeps the rest of the ship in abject submission. The art of propaganda and the use of brutal coercion, the mark of tyranny, define our lives just as they mark those on Melville’s ship. [C.L.R. James](#), for this reason, describes “Moby Dick” as “the biography of the last days of Adolf Hitler.”

And yet Ahab is no simple tyrant. Melville toward the end of the novel gives us two glimpses into the internal battle between Ahab’s maniacal hubris and his humanity. Ahab, too, has a yearning for love. He harbors regrets

over his deformed life. The black cabin boy Pip is the only crew member who evokes any tenderness in the captain. Ahab is aware of this tenderness. He fears its power. Pip functions as the Fool did in Shakespeare's "King Lear." Ahab warns Pip of Ahab. "Lad, lad," says Ahab, "I tell thee thou must not follow Ahab now. The hour is coming when Ahab would not scare thee from him, yet would not have thee by him. There is that in thee, poor lad, which I feel too curing to my malady. Like cures like; and for this hunt, my malady becomes my most desired health. ... If thou speakest thus to me much more, Ahab's purpose keels up in him. I tell thee no; it cannot be." A few pages later, "untottering Ahab stood forth in the clearness of the morn; lifting his splintered helmet of a brow to the fair girl's forehead of heaven. ... From beneath his slouched hat Ahab dropped a tear into the sea; nor did all the Pacific contain such wealth as that one wee drop." Starbuck approaches him. Ahab, for the only time in the book, is vulnerable. He speaks to Starbuck of his "forty years on the pitiless sea! ... the desolation of solitude it has been. ... Why this strife of the chase? why weary, and palsy the arm at the oar, and the iron, and the lance? How the richer or better is Ahab now?" He thinks of his young wife—"I widowed that poor girl when I married her, Starbuck"—and of his little boy: "About this time—yes, it is his noon nap now—the boy vivaciously wakes; sits up in bed; and his mother tells him of me, of cannibal old me; how I am abroad upon the deep, but will yet come back to dance him again."

Ahab's thirst for dominance, vengeance and destruction, however, overpowers these faint regrets of lost love and thwarted compassion. Hatred wins. "What is it," Ahab finally asks, "what nameless, inscrutable, unearthly thing is it; what cozening, hidden lord and master, and cruel, remorseless emperor commands me; that against all natural lovings and longings, I so keep pushing, and crowding, and jamming myself on all the time. ..."

Melville knew that physical courage and moral courage are distinct. One can be brave on a whaling ship or a battlefield, yet a coward when called on to stand up to human evil. Starbuck elucidates this peculiar division. The first mate is tormented by his complicity in what he foresees as Ahab's "impious end." Starbuck, "while generally abiding firm in the conflict with seas, or winds, or whales, or any of the ordinary irrational horrors of the world, yet cannot withstand those more terrific, because spiritual terrors, which sometimes menace you from the concentrating brow of an enraged and mighty man."

And so we plunge forward in our doomed quest to master the forces that will finally smite us. Those who see where we are going lack the fortitude to rebel. Mutiny was the only salvation for the Pequod's crew. It is our only salvation. But moral cowardice turns us into hostages.

Moby Dick rams and sinks the Pequod. The waves swallow up Ahab and all who followed him, except one. A vortex formed by the ship's descent collapses, "and the great shroud of the sea rolled on as it rolled five thousand years ago."

Careful there, John—don't wanna burst a blood vessel

By now, you're probably familiar with [the brilliant move](#) that at least half a dozen states have taken to preserve food stamp coverage, despite Republican attempts to cut the program under the recently passed farm bill. The new law requires that certain food stamp recipients receive at least \$20 in home heating assistance per year in order to still qualify for food aid. Previously, as little as \$1 a year in heating help was enough to make many people eligible for food stamps.

So a number of states, including New York, Pennsylvania, and Montana, had a very simple response: bump up everyone's heating aid to \$20 a year. That cost New York, for instance, just \$6 million in state funds but allowed \$457 million in federal benefits to keep flowing to 300,000 families. Conservatives, predictably, are outraged, and Republican House John Boehner looks like he's about to [pop an orange aneurysm](#):

"Since the passage of the farm bill, **states have found ways to cheat**, once again, on signing up people for food stamps. And so I would hope that the House would act to try to **stop this cheating and this fraud** from continuing."

It's a fascinating world we live in, where following *the letter of the law* is now considered "cheating" and "fraud" by Republicans (as long as you're helping the disadvantaged, of course). And note that it's not just Democrats who've increased heating assistance—Pennsylvania's Republican governor has signed on as well.


Of course, Boehner is full of crap, because the law's the law and it's not getting changed any time soon. But there are nine other states that make use of the "heat and eat" program that haven't yet followed suit, and Boehner may just be trying to intimidate them into inaction. There's no reason for anyone to listen to him, though, because following the law is both perfectly legal and absolutely the right thing to do.

Crimea in the Russian Empire: 1783–1917

A map of what was called New Russia during the time of the [Russian Empire](#). Only the parts of New Russia that are now in Ukraine are shown.

The [Taurida Oblast](#) was created by a decree of [Catherine the Great](#) on 2 February 1784. The center of the [oblast](#) was first in [Karasubazar](#) but was moved to Simferopol later in 1784. The establishment decree divided the oblast into 7 [uyezds](#). However, by a decree of [Paul I](#) on 12 December 1796, the oblast was abolished and the territory, divided into 2 uyezds ([Akmechetsky \[Акмечетский\]](#) and [Perekopsky \[Перекопский\]](#)) was attached to the second incarnation of the [Novorossiysk Governorate](#).

After 1799, the territory was divided into uyezds. At that time, there were 1,400 inhabited villages and 7 towns—Simferopol, Sevastopol, Yalta, Yevpatoria, Alushta, Feodosiya, and Kerch.

In 1802, in the course of Paul I's administrative reform of areas that were annexed from the Crimean Khanate, the Novorossiysk Governorate was again abolished and subdivided. Crimea was attached to a new [Taurida Governorate](#) established with its centre at Simferopol. The governorate included both the 25,133 km² Crimea as well as 38,405 km² of adjacent areas of the mainland.

By the late 19th century, [Crimean Tatars](#) continued to form a slight plurality of Crimea's still largely rural population but there were large numbers of [Russians](#) and Ukrainians as well as smaller numbers of [Germans](#), Jews (including [Krymchaks](#) and [Crimean Karaites](#)), [Bulgarians](#), Belarussians, [Turks](#), [Armenians](#), and [Greeks](#) and Gypsies.

The Tatars were the predominant portion of the population in the mountainous area and about half of the steppe population. Russians were concentrated most heavily in Feodosiya district. Germans and Bulgarians settled in the Crimea at the beginning of 19th century, receiving a large allotment and fertile land and later wealthy colonists began to buy land, mainly in Perekopsky and Evpatoria uyezds.

The Crimean War (1853–1856), a conflict fought between the [Russian Empire](#) and an alliance of the [French Empire](#), the [British Empire](#), the [Ottoman Empire](#), the [Kingdom of Sardinia](#), and the [Duchy of Nassau](#), was part of a long-running contest between the major European powers for influence over territories of the [declining Ottoman Empire](#). While some of the war was fought elsewhere, the principal engagements were in Crimea.

Following action in the [Danubian Principalities](#) and in the Black Sea, allied troops landed in Crimea in September 1854 and [besieged the city of Sevastopol](#), home of the Tsar's Black Sea Fleet and the associated threat of potential Russian penetration into the Mediterranean. After extensive fighting throughout Crimea, the city fell on 9 September 1855.

The war devastated much of the economic and social infrastructure of Crimea. The Crimean Tatars had to flee from their homeland *en masse*, forced by the conditions created by the war, persecution and land expropriations. Those who survived the trip, famine and disease, resettled in [Dobruja](#), [Anatolia](#), and other parts of the [Ottoman Empire](#). Finally, the Russian government decided to stop the process, as the agriculture began to suffer due to the unattended fertile farmland.

Crimea in the Russian Civil War: 1917–1921

Following the [Russian Revolution of 1917](#), the military and political situation in Crimea was chaotic like that in much of Russia. During the ensuing [Russian Civil War](#), Crimea changed hands numerous times and was for a

time a stronghold of the anti-Bolshevik [White Army](#). It was in Crimea that the White Russians led by [General Wrangel](#) made their last stand against [Nestor Makhno](#) and the [Red Army](#) in 1920. When resistance was crushed, many of the anti-Communist fighters and civilians escaped by ship to [Istanbul](#).

Crimea changed hands several times over the course of the conflict and several political entities were set up on the peninsula. These included:

- [Government of South Russia](#) — April 1920 (officially, 16 August 1920)–16 November 1920 — Government of White movement's General [Pyotr Wrangel](#)

Crimea in the Soviet Union: 1922–1991

Interbellum Soviet history

On October 18, 1921, the [Crimean Autonomous Soviet Socialist Republic](#) was created as part of the [Russian SFSR](#) which, in turn, became part of the new [Soviet Union](#).^[5] However, this did not protect the Crimean Tatars, who constituted about 25% of the Crimean population,^[8] from [Joseph Stalin's](#) repressions of the 1930s.^[5] The [Greeks](#) were another cultural group that suffered. Their lands were lost during the process of [collectivisation](#), in which farmers were not compensated with wages. Schools which taught [Greek](#) were closed and [Greek literature](#) was destroyed, because the Soviets considered the Greeks as "counter-revolutionary" with their links to [capitalist](#) state [Greece](#), and their independent culture.^[5]

Crimea experienced two severe famines in the 20th century, the [Famine of 1921–1922](#) and the [Holodomor](#) of 1932–1933.^[9] A large Slavic population influx occurred in the 1930s as a result of the Soviet policy of regional development. With These demographic changes permanently altered the ethnic balance in the region.

World War II and ethnic deportations

During [World War II](#), Crimea was a scene of some of the bloodiest battles. The leaders of the [Third Reich](#) were anxious to conquer and colonize the fertile and beautiful peninsula as part of their policy of resettling the Germans in Eastern Europe at the expense of the Slavs. The Germans suffered heavy casualties in the summer of 1941 as they tried to advance through the narrow [Isthmus of Perekop](#) linking Crimea to the Soviet mainland. Once the German army broke through ([Operation Trappenjagd](#)), they occupied most of Crimea, with the exception of the city of Sevastopol, which was later awarded the honorary title of [Hero City](#) after the war. The [Red Army](#) lost over 170,000 men killed or taken prisoner, and three armies (44th, 47th, and 51st) with twenty-one divisions.^[10]

Sevastopol held out from October 1941 until 4 July 1942 when the Germans finally captured the city. From 1 September 1942, the peninsula was administered as the *Generalbezirk Krim* (general district of Crimea) *und Teilbezirk* (and sub-district) *Taurien* by the Nazi *Generalkommissar* [Alfred Eduard Frauenfeld](#) (1898–1977), under the authority of the three consecutive [Reichskommissare](#) for the entire Ukraine. In spite of heavy-handed tactics by the Nazis and the assistance of the [Romanian](#) and [Italian](#) troops, the Crimean mountains remained an unconquered stronghold of the native resistance (the partisans) until the day when the peninsula was freed from the occupying force.

In 1944, Sevastopol came under the control of troops from the [Soviet Union](#). The so-called "City of Russian Glory" once known for its beautiful architecture was entirely destroyed and had to be rebuilt stone by stone. Due to its enormous historical and symbolic meaning for the Russians, it became a priority for Stalin and the Soviet government to have it restored to its former glory within the shortest time possible.

On 18 May 1944, the entire population of the [Crimean Tatars](#) were [forcibly deported](#) in the "[Sürgün](#)" (Crimean Tatar for exile) to Central Asia by [Joseph Stalin](#)'s Soviet government as a form of [collective punishment](#) on the grounds that they had collaborated with the [Nazi](#) occupation forces.^{[3]:483} An estimated 46% of the deportees died^[citation needed] from hunger and disease. On 26 June of the same year [Armenian](#), [Bulgarian](#) and [Greek](#) population was also deported to Central Asia. By the end of summer 1944, the [ethnic cleansing](#) of Crimea was complete. In 1967, the Crimean Tatars were rehabilitated, but they were banned from legally returning to their homeland until the last days of the Soviet Union. The Crimean Autonomous Soviet Socialist Republic was abolished in 30 June 1945 and transformed into the [Crimean Oblast](#) ([province](#)) of the [Russian SFSR](#).

Post-war Soviet history

On 19 February 1954, the Presidium of the [Supreme Soviet](#) of the USSR issued a decree on the transfer of the

Crimean region of the RSFSR to the Ukrainian SSR. This Supreme Soviet Decree states that this transfer was motivated by "the commonality of the economy, the proximity, and close economic and cultural relations between the Crimean region and the Ukrainian SSR".^[11]

In post-war years, Crimea thrived as a [tourist destination](#), with new attractions and sanatoriums for tourists. Tourists came from all around the Soviet Union and neighbouring countries, particularly from the [German Democratic Republic](#).^[5] In time the peninsula also became a major tourist destination for cruises originating in Greece and Turkey. Crimea's infrastructure and manufacturing also developed, particularly around the sea ports at [Kerch](#) and [Sevastopol](#) and in the oblast's landlocked capital, [Simferopol](#). Populations of [Ukrainians](#) and [Russians](#) alike doubled, with more than 1.6 million Russians and 626,000 Ukrainians living on the peninsula by 1989.^[5]

Crimea within independent Ukraine

Establishment of the Autonomous Republic: 1991–1998

With the [collapse of the Soviet Union](#), Crimea became part of the newly independent Ukraine. Independence was supported by a [referendum](#) in all regions of Ukrainian SSR, including Crimea.^[12] 54% of the Crimean voters supported independence with a 60% turnout (in Sevastopol 57% supported independence).^[13] The percentage of the total Crimean electorate that had voted for Ukrainian independence in the referendum was 37%.^[14] In 1994, the legal status of Crimea as part of Ukraine was backed up by Russia, who pledged to uphold the territorial integrity of Ukraine in a [memorandum signed in 1994](#), also signed by the US, UK and France.^[15]^[16]

This new situation led to tensions between Russia and Ukraine. With the [Black Sea Fleet](#) based on the peninsula, worries of armed skirmishes were occasionally raised. In August 1991, [Yuriy Meshkov](#) established the Republican Movement of Crimea which was registered on 19 November.^[15]

On 2 September 1991, the National Movement of Crimean Tatars appealed to the V Extraordinary Congress of People's Deputies in Russia demanding the program how to return the deported Tatar population back to Crimea. Based on the resolution of the [Verkhovna Rada](#) (the Crimean parliament) on 26 February 1992, the Crimean ASSR was renamed the Republic of Crimea.^[17] The Crimean parliament proclaimed self-government on 5 May 1992.^[18]^[17] (which was yet to be approved by a referendum to be held 2 August 1992^[19]) and passed the first [Crimean constitution](#) the same day.^[19] On 6 May 1992 the same parliament inserted a new sentence into this constitution that declared that Crimea was part of Ukraine.^[19]

On 19 May, Crimea agreed to remain as part of Ukraine and annulled their proclamation of self-government. By 30 June, Crimean Communists forced the [Kiev](#) government to expand on the already extensive autonomous status of Crimea. [3]:587 In the same period, Russian president [Boris Yeltsin](#) and Ukraine's [Leonid Kravchuk](#) agreed to divide the former [Soviet Black Sea Fleet](#) between Russia and the newly formed [Ukrainian Navy](#). [20] On 24 October, Meshkov re-registered his movement as the *Republican Party of Crimea – Party of the Republican Movement of Crimea*. On 11 December 1992, the [President of Ukraine](#) called the attempt of "the Russian deputies to charge the Russian parliament with a task to define the status of [Sevastopol](#) as an *imperial disease*". [21] On 17 December 1992, the office of the Ukrainian presidential representative in Crimea was created, which caused wave of protests a month later. Among the protesters that created the unsanctioned rally were the Sevastopol branches of the National Salvation Front, the Russian Popular Assembly, and the All-Crimean Movement of *the Voters for the Republic of Crimea*. The protest was held in Sevastopol on 10 January at [Nakhimov Square](#).

On 15 January 1993, Kravchuk and Yeltsin in the meeting in Moscow appointed Eduard Baltin as the commander of the Black Sea Fleet. At the same time the Union of the Ukrainian Naval Officers protested the Russian intervention into the Ukrainian internal affairs. Soon after that there were more anti-Ukrainian protests led by the Meshkov's party, the Voters for the Crimean Republic, [Yedinstvo](#), and the Union of Communists that demanded to turn [Sevastopol](#) under the Russian jurisdiction and followed by the interview given by the Sevastopol's Communist, Vasyl Parkhomenko, who said that the city's Communists request to recognize the Russian as the state language and restoration of the Soviet Union. On 19 March 1993, the Crimean deputy and the member of the National Salvation Front, Alexander Kruglov, threatened the members of the Crimean Ukrainian Congress not allow into the building of the Republican Council. Couple of days after that Russia established an information center in [Sevastopol](#). In April 1993, the Ukrainian Ministry of Defence submitted an appeal to [Verkhovna Rada](#) to suspend the [Yalta Agreement of 1992](#) that divided the Black Sea Fleet that was followed by the request from the Ukrainian Republican Party to recognize the Fleet either fully Ukrainian or a *fleet of a foreign country in Ukraine*. Also over 300 Russian legislators called the planned Congress of Ukrainian Residents a political provocation.

On 14 April 1993, the Presidium of the Crimean parliament called for the creation of the presidential post of the Crimean Republic. A week later the Russian deputy, Valentin Agafonov, stated that Russia is ready to supervise the referendum on Crimean independence and include the republic as a separate entity in the CIS. On 28 July 1993, one of the leaders of the Russian Society of Crimea, Viktor Prusakov, stated that his organization is ready for an armed mutiny and establishment of the Russian administration in Sevastopol. In September, Eduard Baltin accused Ukraine of converting some of his fleet and conducting an armed assault on his personnel, and threatened to take *countermeasures* of placing the fleet on alert.

On 14 October 1993, the Crimean parliament established the post of [President of Crimea](#) and agreed on the quota of the Crimean Tatars representation in the Council to 14. The head of the Russian People's Council in Sevastopol, Alexander Kruglov, called it *excessive*. The chairman of the Tatar [Mejlis](#), [Mustafa Abdülcemil Qırımoğlu](#), used words "categorically against" in regards to the proposed election for Crimean president on 16 January. He stated that there cannot be two presidents in a single state. On 6 November, the Crimean Tatar leader, [Yuriy Osmanov](#) was murdered. Series of terrorist actions rocked the peninsula in the winter among them were the arson of the Mejlis apartment, the shooting of a Ukrainian official, several hooligan attacks on Meshkov, the bomb explosion in the house of a local parliamentary, the assassination attempt on a Communist presidential candidate, and others. On 2 January 1994, the Mejlis announced a boycott of the presidential elections, which were later canceled. The boycott itself was later taken on by other Crimean Tatar organizations. On 11 January, the Mejlis announced their representative, [Mykola Bahrov](#), the speaker of the Crimean parliament, as the presidential candidate. On 12 January, some other candidates accused Bahrov of severe methods of agitation. At the same time, [Vladimir Zhirinovskiy](#) called on the people of Crimea to vote for the Russian Sergei

Shuvainikov.

On 30 January 1994, the pro-Russian [Yuriy Meshkov](#) was [elected to the new post](#) but quickly ran into conflicts with parliament. On 8 September, the Crimean parliament degraded the President's powers from the head of state to the head of the executive power only, to which Meshkov responded by disbanding parliament and announcing his control over Crimea four days later. Amendments[[clarification needed](#)] to the constitution eased the conflict[[citation needed](#)], but on 17 March 1995, the [parliament of Ukraine](#) intervened, scrapping the Crimean Constitution and removing Meshkov along with his office for his actions against the state and promoting integration with [Russia](#).[\[22\]](#) After an interim constitution lasting from 4 April 1996 to 23 December 1998, the current constitution was put into effect, changing the territory's name to the Autonomous Republic of Crimea.

Autonomous Republic of Crimea: 1999–2013

Following the ratification of the May 1997 Treaty of Friendship, Cooperation, and Partnership on friendship and division of the [Black Sea Fleet](#), international tensions slowly eased off. With the treaty, [Moscow](#) recognized Ukraine's borders and territorial integrity, and accepted Ukraine's sovereignty over Crimea and Sevastopol.[\[3\]:600](#) In a separate agreement, Russia was to receive 80 percent of the Black Sea Fleet and use of the military facilities in Sevastopol on a 20-year [lease](#).[\[3\]:600](#)

However, other controversies between Ukraine and Russia still remain, including the ownership of a [lighthouse](#) on [Cape Sarych](#). Because the [Russian Navy](#) controlled 77 geographical objects on the south Crimean Shore, the [Sevastopol](#) Government Court ordered the vacating of the objects, which the Russian military did not carry out.[\[23\]](#) Since August 3, 2005, the lighthouse has been controlled by the [Russian Army](#).[\[24\]](#) Through the years, there have been various attempts to return Cape Sarych to Ukrainian territory, all of which were unsuccessful.

In 2006, [protests broke out](#) on the peninsula after [U.S. Marines](#)[\[25\]](#) arrived at the Crimean city of [Feodosiya](#) to take part in the Sea Breeze 2006 [Ukraine-NATO military exercise](#). Protesters greeted the marines with barricades and slogans bearing "Occupiers go home!" and a couple of days later, the [Crimean parliament](#) declared Crimea a "NATO-free territory." After several days of protest, the U.S. Marines withdrew from the peninsula.[\[26\]](#)

In September 2008, the [Ukrainian Foreign Minister Volodymyr Ohryzko](#) accused Russia of giving out [Russian passports](#) to the population in the Crimea and described it as a "real problem" given Russia's declared policy of military intervention abroad to protect Russian citizens.[\[27\]](#)

During a press conference in [Moscow](#) on 16 February 2009, the [Mayor](#) of [Sevastopol](#) Serhiy Kunitsyn claimed (citing recent polls) that the population of Crimea is opposed to the idea of becoming a part of [Russia](#).[\[28\]](#)

Although western newspapers like the [Wall Street Journal](#) have speculated about a Russian [coup](#) in Sevastopol or another Crimean city in connection with the [Russian-Georgian war](#) and the [Recognition of Abkhazia and](#)

[South Ossetia by Russia](#).^[29] Valentyn Nalyvaychenko, acting head of the [Security Service of Ukraine](#) (SBU), stated on 17 February 2009, that he is confident that any "[Ossetian](#) scenario" is impossible in Crimea.^[30] The SBU had started criminal proceedings against the pro-Russian association "People's front Sevastopol-Crimea-Russia" in January 2009.^[31]

On the 55th anniversary of the transfer of Crimea transfer of the [Russian SFSR](#) to the [Ukrainian SSR](#) (on 19 February 2009) some 300 to 500 people took part in rallies to protest against the transfer.^{[32][33]}

On 24 August 2009, anti-Ukrainian demonstrations were held in Crimea by ethnic Russian residents. [Sergei Tsekov](#) (of the [Russian Bloc](#)^[34] and then deputy speaker of the [Crimean parliament](#)^[35]) said then that he hoped that Russia would treat the Crimea the same way as it had treated South Ossetia and Abkhazia.^[36]

Chaos in the [Verkhovna Rada](#) (the Ukrainian parliament) during a debate over the extension of the lease on a [Russian naval base](#) erupted on 27 April 2010 after Ukraine's parliament ratified [the treaty](#) that extends [Russia's](#) lease on a military wharf and shore installations in the Crimean port [Sevastopol](#) until 2042. The [Chairman of the Verkhovna Rada](#) [Volodymyr Lytvyn](#) had to be shielded by umbrellas as he was pelted with eggs, while smoke bombs exploded and politicians brawled.^{[37][38]} Along with the Verkhovna Rada the treaty was ratified by the Russian [State Duma](#) as well.^[39]

2014 Crimean crisis and Russian Annexation

On 26 February 2014, [thousands of pro-Russian and pro-Ukraine protesters clashed](#) in front of the parliament building in [Simferopol](#). On the same day Russian President [Vladimir Putin](#) put 2,000 Russian troops on alert along the Ukrainian border. The protests followed the ousting of the Ukraine President [Viktor Yanukovych](#) on 22 February 2014, and a push by pro-Russian protesters for Crimea to secede from Ukraine and seek assistance from Russia.^[40]

On 28 February 2014, Russian military forces occupied key posts, buildings, airports, and other assets in Crimea.^[41] The interim Government of Ukraine described the events as an invasion and occupation of Crimea by Russian forces.^{[42][43]} Crimean Prime Minister [Sergey Aksyonov](#), elected in an emergency session earlier in the week, said he asserted sole control over Crimea's security forces and appealed to Russia "for assistance in guaranteeing peace and calmness" on the peninsula. The central Ukrainian government does not recognize the Aksyonov administration and considers it illegal. ^[44] ^[45] The Russian foreign ministry stated that "*movement of the Black Sea Fleet armored vehicles in Crimea (...) happens in full accordance with basic Russian-Ukrainian agreements on the Black Sea Fleet*".^[46]

On March 1, the Russian parliament granted President [Vladimir Putin](#) the authority to use military force in Ukraine.^[47] The U.S. and the European Union condemned this move. On the same day, the acting president of Ukraine, [Oleksandr Turchynov](#) decreed the appointment of the [Prime Minister of Crimea](#) as unconstitutional.^[48]

On the 6th of March 2014, the Crimean parliament voted in favour of joining Russia in a union between the two nations. An official referendum on the matter is to be held on the 16th of March. However, the local referendum is not allowed according to the Ukrainian Constitution and laws, thus not legitimate.
