General Presentation

Médecins Sans Frontières (MSF) is an international medical humanitarian organization that provides assistance to populations in distress, victims of natural or man-made disasters and armed conflict in more than 65 countries worldwide. MSF's mandate is to save lives and alleviate suffering by working directly with those in need, regardless of race, religion, ethnicity, gender, political affiliation or any other factor. The organization was awarded the Nobel Peace Prize in 1999.

In Myanmar, MSF has been working since 1992 and is currently providing healthcare in Shan, Rakhine, and Kachin states, as well as Yangon and Thanintharyi regions. Over 1,000 international and national staff work closely together to provide high-quality care and treatment through a network of health centres, health posts and mobile clinics. The teams are made up of highly qualified medical staff, administrators, coordinators and experts in various medical, logistics, water and sanitation fields.

Main of task and responsibilities

PHC Clinic duties/Malaria

- To be responsible for the management and treatment of all patients according to MSF protocols/guidelines, consulting at the PHC clinic or Malaria mobile clinic.
- Together with medical expat, to be responsible for the medical supervision of CHW, TBA, nutrition, ANC program, TB, STI and Malaria program.
- To be responsible for the daily management and supervision of the PHC clinic and staff including malaria site, as requested.
- To be responsible for the drug order for the clinic, as requested.
- To train and monitor of CHW and TBA.
- To make proper referrals of severe patients to DoH facilities according to referral protocol.
- To collect data and report about mortality and patients treated at PHC or Malaria clinic
- For STI patients, to ensure priority for the target groups and to establish a good relation with them.
- To perform home care visits when and where necessary.
- To participate in outreach activities if required
- To provide solid medical care to malnourished children according to MSF nutrition protocols.
- To cooperate with other MD's and medical supervisors in developing and implementing new clinic initiatives.
- To participate in completing work schedules as needed in case of shortages or absences

HIV Clinic duties

- To provide appropriate clinical care to PHA patients, including diagnosis of OI's and IRS, ARV treatment and management of drug side effects.
- To determine when a patient should start ARV treatment and prepare the patient.
- To prepare pre-ART baseline investigations and to ensure all requirements are fulfilled for ART treatment.
- To ensure patient's adherence to ART and to monitor progress and side effects.

- To organise the patient appointment book, registers and regular follow-up schedule.
- To maintain clear and complete documentation on patients (FUCHIA, summary sheet, etc).
- For TB patients, to ensure proper TB counselling/health education has been given, and provide appropriate care according to guidelines.
- For STI patients, to ensure priority for the target groups and to establish a good relation with them.
- To perform home care visits when and where necessary.
- To cooperate with other MD's and medical supervisors in developing and implementing new clinic initiatives.

Requirements

- Good knowledge of the issues surrounding STI, HIV/AIDS and TB
- Good command of English, both written and spoken
- Flexible and empathetic attitude
- Able to work in a multicultural context
- Motivated to work in the field and/or remote areas
