

CONFERENCE CALL

Lyn: Go to John Oliver you tubes: look up "Asset Forfeiture" and others – 12- 18 minutes each

- At a meeting for Bernie Sanders today; the idea of robotic drone warfare came up, plus

the reality that it is being hidden; youth in china, the US are being programmed for war;
this is really bothering people

T: Who gave the youth access to the maps?

Lyn: Google Maps

T: Who is behind Google Maps?

L: the kids can find out by themselves – they are being recruited out of Portland at the Jr High Level via video games [a couple of years ago]

T: at this level, it is all sewed up by the black Ops – we have to stop them from the other side; we have to de-program the kids too. Brings up

L: that is what the healing arts programs etc are for

T: that is true;

T : brings up the fact that Robert Bryd was programmed once; he was put in a trance; walked out the door and was gone for 4 days; when he returned, he had no memory of what he had done [sex with young kids and so forth] – this is what is happening with the kids. And if or when the kids wake up, they really need help.

C2: Jimmy Carter and Obama attend a UN meeting scheduled in NYC – any galactic intel about what is supposed to be discussed? like refugees, etc – supposed to be momentous

- And Lyn was talking about the young people being programmed to fight – and the kids who go and fight want out of there!
- There has to be real mastery here: how to find balance: they can tap into your past lives and use that against you in this life via programming.

T: cost of the war is \$6Trillion and counting

Lyn: From a 60 minutes program in 2009, Katy Kurs as host:

- she went over to see the Seals training Afghans how to use guns – had troubles because they could not really understand the language.
- Important to understand that the gov't was / is spending millions to drug war lords in Afghanistan
- Exchange rate is same as in Africa: 60 to 1, or 100 to 1 – can check this through Veteransforpeace.org

T: Zimbabwe – it's 1000 to one! And there is ignorance over here: people say let's devalue the Zimbabwe and all will be well!

Lyn: UN Report that world's poverty is to be handled by 2030

T: the Pope is supposed to address the UN about this

Lyn: people need to realize that all the groups have so much to do – the people will get \$2600 per month to work at whatever they want to do; enough work for everyone!

T: we need to clear out the stuff inside us that can panic, anger us – and don't harm our own physical bodies

- **Bernie Sanders on Steve Colbert** last night: looked like his aura needed a bit of work! But he is focussed and energetic: do what you can and don't push self too hard: referred to Kaypacha's message of tonight.
- Refugee camp in Syria – dysentery

C2: we will continue to send light and love to the refugees and follow the links from Lyn who has given us lots of links.

- Re children: was in a waiting room with his daughter; a DVD was playing of the Harry Potter movie; as he watched it, realized it was high science! Words like "wizard" = wise, not evil; sorcerer = the source

T: they were living with a friend in 1997-9; his 2 daughters lived with the mother in Taos and stayed with him on weekends; during the summer, it was the dad, the 2 kids, and T & R.

- One was an artist; won an all school contest and went to an art school in Berkley – drew hobbits, cat people, etc with no training!
- Sister read all the books of Harry Potter avidly!
- Gave her own son the complete set of **The Children of Doom:** finished them in a month, looked for more!
- Harry Potter, Children of Doom, Lord of the Rings – all connected

Lyn: time to get kids connected to their inner light, their guardian angels

- Elizabeth Rose had a radio show for 30 years; the daughter Maya went with her father to pick mushrooms in the forest – they saw tree spirits and all kinds of things, came home and wrote stories for the others. Author Interview: Lisa Bloom

Lisa Bloom author of *Suspicion Nation*, took time out of her busy schedule to give insight on her book and speaking engagements for Books In Common.

What are some of the “teachable” moments in your book that make it work well for a speaking engagement?

Racial bias: No one thinks she is racist in twenty-first century America, and yet racially disparate outcomes are all around us. Blacks are four times as likely as whites to be arrested and incarcerated for marijuana possession, for example, though the two groups use at the same rates. White men with felony convictions are more like to get the job than black men with clean records, when both have identical resumes. And on and on. How is this possible? The answer: implicit racial bias, the field of study that administers cheat-proof tests for hidden racial bias. It turns out that 80% of whites and 50% of blacks test for moderate or severe racial bias against African Americans. The good news: once we’re aware of our subconscious biases, we can eradicate them.

I cover this topic extensively in my book, *Suspicion Nation*, because racial profiling was at the heart of the Trayvon Martin case, as it is in so many cases.

Pretending we live in colorblind America, ignoring evidence of racial bias, is not helping us advance. It is holding us back. The “teachable moment” is the mountain of evidence that racial bias still plagues us, but also the fixes that can help us overcome it. As Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. said: “All we say to America is be true to what you said on paper.”

Would you share some notable experiences you’ve had at speaking events that you’ve participated in?

Very enthusiastic! I’ve been bowled over by hugs from strangers, standing ovations, sold out events, and every time, far more hands up in Q and A sessions than I could answer in the time allotted.

What inspired you to write this story?

I covered the George Zimmerman trial gavel to gavel for NBC News and MSNBC, and as I did, I saw a grave injustice unfolding right before our eyes. I saw a prosecution team that wasn’t arguing its strongest evidence, was putting on unprepared witnesses, and gave such a weak closing argument that both sides seemed to be arguing reasonable doubt, assuring an acquittal. When the case was over, I had to know what happened, what we weren’t seeing on TV. So I did my own investigation, and the results were shocking, and became my book, *Suspicion Nation*. My conclusion is that the State of Florida bungled the case from beginning to end, but also, that our culture and laws created the perfect storm that allowed this case — and many others like it — to happen.

Many people felt in their gut that the Trayvon Martin case was an injustice. I did too. But a gut feeling wasn’t good enough. I had to get the facts. Once I had them, I had to expose this injustice for what it was. That’s why I wrote the book.

Your latest book, *Suspicion Nation*, is a very current look at racial injustice. What do you think are some of the more engaging discussion topics, and why?

Why are we so uncomfortable talking about race?

Black America largely feels that white America no longer believes that racism is a problem. Are they right?

What can we do to push forward on this issue and truly become an egalitarian society?

What about gun laws? Stand Your Ground laws? How did they contribute to this case? Are they creating a more dangerous, violent country?

Suspicion Nation Interview with Publishers Weekly, "And Justice For All"

In summer 2013, civil rights attorney and legal analyst Lisa Bloom covered the trial of George Zimmerman—who was accused of murdering 17-year-old Trayvon Martin in Sanford, Fla.—for NBC. Halfway through the proceedings, Bloom had an “aha” moment that planted the seed for her forthcoming book, *Suspicion Nation: The Inside Story of the Trayvon Martin Injustice and Why We Continue to Repeat It* (Counterpoint, Feb. 26).

“I started to notice there was a great deal of very powerful evidence in the case that the prosecutors weren’t arguing,” Bloom says. “One of the most important pieces of evidence came from Zimmerman’s videotaped reenactment for the police, where he states that Trayvon saw his gun, holstered behind his right hip, and reached for it during their scuffle, which is why Zimmerman shot him.” But Bloom, who reviewed the evidence and watched each day’s proceedings during the trial, realized that it wasn’t possible for Martin to have seen the gun—because it was holstered behind Zimmerman, who was lying down and also wearing a shirt and a jacket. “I watched this over and over again and thought, how did they miss this? And what else are they missing?” Bloom says.

It turns out they were missing plenty—so much so that when Bloom flew home after Zimmerman’s acquittal, she couldn’t stop thinking about it. “I really couldn’t let it go,” she says. “A lot of people feel this case was an injustice, but they’re told that the jury system played out and the man was acquitted. But I’m here to say it was an injustice, and from a lawyer’s view inside the courtroom, I can show you what happened—how, by the last week of the trial, the evidence went in one direction, and the prosecution in another.”

Bloom has been a civil rights lawyer since 1986, and she has covered trials for CNN, the *Today Show*, and MSNBC for nearly 20 years, in addition to having her own show on Court TV. She says she wrote the *Suspicion Nation* in less than four months, working around the clock. “I wanted to do it right away, while this issue is still very much pressing in people’s minds.” Bloom’s book includes a great deal of new information, which she uncovered after interviewing Martin’s friend Rachel Jeantell, who testified during the trial, as well as one of the jurors on the case, who told her about what went on in the jury room. “My book has a lot of behind-the-scenes information, and it’s going to surprise a lot of people about the evidence that was there and that the prosecution missed,” Bloom says. “The state of Florida bungled the case from prosecutor to closing arguments to judge.”

It was natural for Bloom to take up civil rights law when she graduated from Yale law school. Her mother, attorney Gloria Allred, is a lawyer known for representing celebrity clients and taking on women’s discrimination cases. Her father, Peyton Bray, was “a hippie radical until his last days—a great, fierce independent thinker and the smartest guy I ever knew,” Bloom says. “He would give me books about anarchy inscribed, ‘To Lisa, Smash the state! Love, Dad,’ when I was 12 years old.” Bloom’s law practice in Los Angeles focuses on domestic violence, sexual harassment, and racial discrimination cases. The Bloom Firm includes four attorneys—“all of them women,” she says with a smile.

The corporate law route never appealed to Bloom. “There are plenty of lawyers happy to do that who are well paid,” she says. “I wanted to do something I believed in and cared about. I wake up every morning and I’m excited. We go up against fleets of lawyers with their investigators and publicists, so we have to be smarter

and more nimble. But we can beat them, and we do.”

Suspicion Nation also delves into the issue of racial profiling in the U.S. “It runs rampant in our system,” Bloom says. “Also, our lax gun laws mean there are too many people like Zimmerman who have guns and use them with little accountability.” As part of her research, she visited the scene of the Martin shooting, in Sanford. While there, she began to question another aspect of Zimmerman’s defense: he said that Martin banged his head repeatedly on the concrete, prompting him to shoot the teenager in self-defense. “Trayvon’s body was found on the lawn, a substantial distance from the concrete. That negates part of the self-defense story. Zimmerman’s head injuries were not consistent with his head repeatedly hitting concrete.”

In her book, Bloom recounts several incidents similar to the Martin shooting that have occurred since then. “And those are just the ones that have gotten publicity,” she notes. “Racial profiling is everywhere. It doesn’t just happen in Sanford, but also in Michigan and Wisconsin and New York City. A lot of this is reminiscent of trials from the civil rights era in small towns in the South, where a white person kills a black person and walks.”

Bloom is passionate about finding ways to prevent more crimes—and trials—like Zimmerman’s. “We need more black prosecutors, for one thing,” she says. “Only about 5% of them are black. Prosecutors are more powerful than judges: they decide whether to charge a person or not, what to charge the defendant with, which plea bargains will be offered, and how sentencing is determined.”

Suspicion Nation also suggests that judges should reconsider how they give jurors instructions before each trial. “For instance, a judge could say, ‘Most of us, including myself, are [racially] biased in one way or another. Set aside these biases while you’re serving on this jury. Change the race of the person on trial in your mind and see how that affects your judgment.’”

Suspicion Nation is set to be published on the second anniversary of Martin’s death, and it will be the first book about the Zimmerman trial. “The Trayvon Martin case is iconic, one that people will be studying 30 years from now,” Bloom says. “And as I discuss in the book, [the verdict] was almost preordained. I wanted there to be something on record that explains what happened and why it went wrong. This was different from a lot of cases I’ve covered—much bigger than just these two guys on that dark night in Sanford, Fla. It really had struck a nerve.”

Stunning Ferguson report revelations: Why a complete overhaul is needed, now



The Ferguson protesters were right. In fact, the corruption was worse than some of them may have realized. The police, courts and city officials systematically, frequently, blatantly violated the constitutional rights of residents, in a system infected to its core with hardcore, KKK-style racism, according to a [scathing new Department of Justice report](#).

The report concludes: Stop blaming the community. Stop blaming the peaceful protestors (and remember, 99 percent were peaceful). Stop blaming "outside agitators." The problem, squarely, is caused by the authorities themselves. It's sickening to read these findings about a 21st century American city, but it would be even more shameful for us to look away.

Ferguson residents endure disrespect, injustice for years

Of course, much the community already knew that they were living in a police state-esque town, riddled with disrespect for its residents. This is why the shooting of Mike Brown by Ferguson police officer Darren Wilson in August 2014 ignited protests. Tensions had been simmering over demeaning, painful injustices inflicted on residents by its police and courts for a very long time. African American residents not only had to endure the constant affronts, but also officials' blithe denials of reality.

Shortly after Brown's shooting, for example, Ferguson Mayor James Knowles said:

"For people to come out and say there's some longstanding anger or there's a history of racial tension is absolutely ridiculous. There's not a black-white divide in Ferguson."

Either Mr. Knowles was straight-up lying or he was stunningly unaware of what was going on under his nose. Either way, he is thus unfit to hold office. Because in just a few months, the U.S. Department of Justice's investigation found [widespread racism in facts](#) like:

- Every single documented police dog bite case was perpetrated on a black person
- Nearly all arrests were of blacks, who make up only 67 percent of the population
- Ticketing and general harassment was overwhelmingly perpetrated on African American

Ferguson officials: Racist jokes behind closed doors, outright persecution in public

The state-sponsored bullying by the majority white police force and court officers is on the level of psychological warfare. This is clear in the case of the woman whose life became a living hell over a single parking ticket she could not afford to pay. She was hit with a barrage of fees, hassles and bureaucratic red tape. She became homeless. She attempted to make partial payments, which the city rejected – adding on fines and penalties instead. She was arrested twice and spent six days in jail, all over that single parking ticket.

While black women like her were tormented by the system, authorities yukked it up over racist emails about them, on their government accounts, like the one about the black woman who had an abortion and then got a check from Crime Stoppers (*get it?! All black babies turn into criminals!*). Or another showing a photo of bare-chested African women with the caption, “Michelle Obama’s high school reunion” (*haha! They’re all foreign, other, sexualized, worthy objects of ridicule!*).

To persecute struggling citizens while simultaneously laughing at them from a powerful perch is sociopathic, sadistic. No one was fired.

Then there’s the case of the 32-year-old African American man cooling off in his car after playing basketball in a Ferguson public park. For his crime of Parking While Black, a police officer pulled up behind him, blocking him in, demanding his social security number and identification. (Do not forget that Darren Wilson was accused of instigating what became a fatal shooting by screeching his car to a halt behind Mike Brown and Dorian Johnson in a strikingly similar manner, cursing at them for jaywalking.) Without any cause, the officer accused the man of being a pedophile, ordering him out of his car. When the man objected to the officer’s request to search his car without any probable cause whatsoever, citing his constitutional rights, the officer arrested the man at gunpoint, charging him with eight violations including “Making a False Declaration” for giving the short form of his first name, like Mike for Michael. Because of these charges, the man lost his job as a federal contractor, which he had held for years.

Meanwhile, Ferguson authorities passed around jokes invoking that pernicious, centuries-old, slave-era stereotype of the Lazy Black Man. When President Barack Obama was first elected, they emailed each other the side-splitter that he wouldn’t serve out his term because “what black man holds a steady job for four years.” While they destroyed at least one black man’s livelihood, they laughed about black men not being able to hold jobs.

No one was disciplined. Instead, authorities receiving this and other racist emails forwarded them on to their buddies. These are the people who run the city, who have the power to arrest, to incarcerate, even to kill. It is they who should now be unemployed.

Add to all of this that in Ferguson, [racism was profitable](#). From top city officials to court officers to police, everyone was instructed to ticket, ticket, ticket the hell out of the community to fill city coffers. And so innocent people, almost always black, were targeted, cited, arrested, fined, over and over again, often for trumped up offenses. One black business owner has said he left early for work each day to leave time for the inevitable police stop.

I write and speak often about [implicit racism](#), but this was *explicit* stuff that leaves no room for doubt or ambiguity. Ferguson officials, it turns out, have much in common with [grand jury Witness 40](#), who was called to give false testimony supportive of officer Wilson, as prosecutor Bob McCulloch later conceded, even though knowingly calling a witness to give false testimony is unethical. She admitted under oath that she'd posted her own racist joke about the Ferguson protestors out grieving in the streets after the killing of Mike Brown: "They need to kill the fucking [N word].. It is like an ape fest."

We were led to believe she was an outlier. She was not. Indeed, we see it even in Wilson's chilling testimony that, in his view, the Ferguson community "was not well liked." Translation: "I don't like the people I am sworn to serve."

One shortcoming in the DOJ report

There is one shortcoming: The DOJ does not appear to have looked at the biased grand jury proceeding that returned no indictment against Wilson, or at the prosecutor's various failings. I did my own [25-minute presentation on the rampant biases in that grand jury](#).

One gets the strong impression that authorities want to be finished with the Wilson matter, and that the DOJ wanted to wrap it up with their determination that they could not prevail on [federal civil rights charges against Officer Wilson](#), even though he worked for the very police force that it found was brimming with racism.

The issue is not whether Wilson is innocent or guilty. The issue is whether there was ever an advocate for Brown in either of the investigations. Certainly there was not in the state investigation, as the transcripts reveal.

DOJ reform suggestions center on basic respect

The DOJ concludes its otherwise thorough report with a good list of reforms, which center on community policing. They all boil down to treating citizens with respect. It's clear to me that everyone in charge needs to be cleared out immediately. A new bunch should be brought in to put all recommended reforms in place, and they should be monitored, carefully and constantly.

But first, how about starting with an apology to the citizens of Ferguson?

2015-09-11 Big Five mass extinction events

Although the Cretaceous-Tertiary (or K-T) extinction event is the most well-known because it wiped out the dinosaurs, a series of other mass extinction events has occurred throughout the history of the Earth, some even more devastating than K-T. Mass extinctions are periods in Earth's history when abnormally large numbers of species die out simultaneously or within a limited time frame. The most severe occurred at the end of the Permian period when 96% of all species perished. This along with K-T are two of the Big Five mass extinctions, each of which wiped out at least half of all species. Many smaller scale mass extinctions have occurred, indeed the disappearance of many animals and plants at the hands of man in prehistoric, historic and modern times will eventually show up in the fossil record as mass extinctions. [Ordovician-Silurian mass extinction](#)

The third largest extinction in Earth's history, the Ordovician-Silurian mass extinction had two peak dying times separated by hundreds of thousands of years. During the Ordovician, most life was in the sea, so it was sea creatures such as trilobites, brachiopods and graptolites that were drastically reduced in number.



[Late Devonian mass extinction](#)

Three quarters of all species on Earth died out in the Late Devonian mass extinction, though it may have been a series of extinctions over several million years, rather than a single event. Life in the shallow seas were the worst affected, and reefs took a hammering, not returning to their former glory until new types of coral evolved over 100 million years later.



[Permian mass extinction](#)

The Permian mass extinction has been nicknamed The Great Dying, since a staggering 96% of species died out. All life on Earth today is descended from the 4% of species that survived.



[Triassic-Jurassic mass extinction](#)

During the final 18 million years of the Triassic period, there were two or three phases of extinction whose combined effects created the Triassic-Jurassic mass extinction event. Climate change, flood basalt eruptions and an asteroid impact have all been blamed for this loss of life.



[Cretaceous-Tertiary mass extinction](#)

The Cretaceous-Tertiary mass extinction - also known as the K/T extinction - is famed for the death of the dinosaurs. However, many other organisms perished at the end of the Cretaceous including the ammonites, many flowering plants and the last of the pterosaurs.

2015-09-19 Constitution Day (United States)

Constitution Day (or **Citizenship Day**) is an [American](#) federal [observance](#) that recognizes the adoption of the [United States Constitution](#) and those who have become U.S. citizens. It is normally observed on September 17, the day in 1787 that delegates to the [Constitutional Convention](#) signed the document in Philadelphia.^[2]

When Constitution Day falls on a weekend or on another holiday, schools and other institutions observe the holiday on an adjacent weekday.^[3]

The law establishing the present holiday was created in 2004 with the passage of an amendment by Senator [Robert Byrd](#) to the [Omnibus spending bill](#) of 2004.^[4] Before this law was enacted, the holiday was known as "Citizenship Day". In addition to renaming the holiday "Constitution Day and Citizenship Day," the act mandates that all publicly funded educational institutions, and all federal agencies, provide educational programming on the history of the American Constitution on that day.^[5] In May 2005, the [United States Department of Education](#) announced the enactment of this "Presidential quote" T-shirts to all students on campus.^[6]
