Venue and registration

The conference will take place in conjunction with the 33rd Task Force Meeting of ICP Forests **at Novotel Bucharest City Center Hotel**, Calea Victoriei 37B, Sector 1, 010061, Bucharest - Romania (<http://www.novotel.com/gb/hotel-5558-novotel-bucharest-city-centre/index.shtml>).

The official currency in Romania is Leu (RON) and the exchange rate is approximately 1€ = 4.5 lei.

Welcome Reception

A welcome reception will be organized in the foyer of the Novotel Bucharest City Center Hotel, on 15th of May in the evening and it will be offered by the organizers.

Field trip

A full day field trip will be organized on 16 May 2017. Participants will have the opportunity to visit one of the famous touristic area in Romania (Prahova Valley) where between 1873 and 1883 Carol I of Romania (1839-1914) build his royal summer residence, the [Peles Castle](#) (Sinaia resort area). Close to this objective is the Bucegi Natural Park visiting Centre (Busteni resort area) which is also included in the programme. After that an ICP-Forests Level II core-plot (Predeal – mold) will be visited on the way to the Bran area, near Brasov where you will find another important and famous castle in Romania (the [Bran Castle](#)). Proper shoes and rain coats are recommended. The final conclusions on what we assure you that it will be a special day can be drawn at the late lunch with local traditional food from the Bran area.

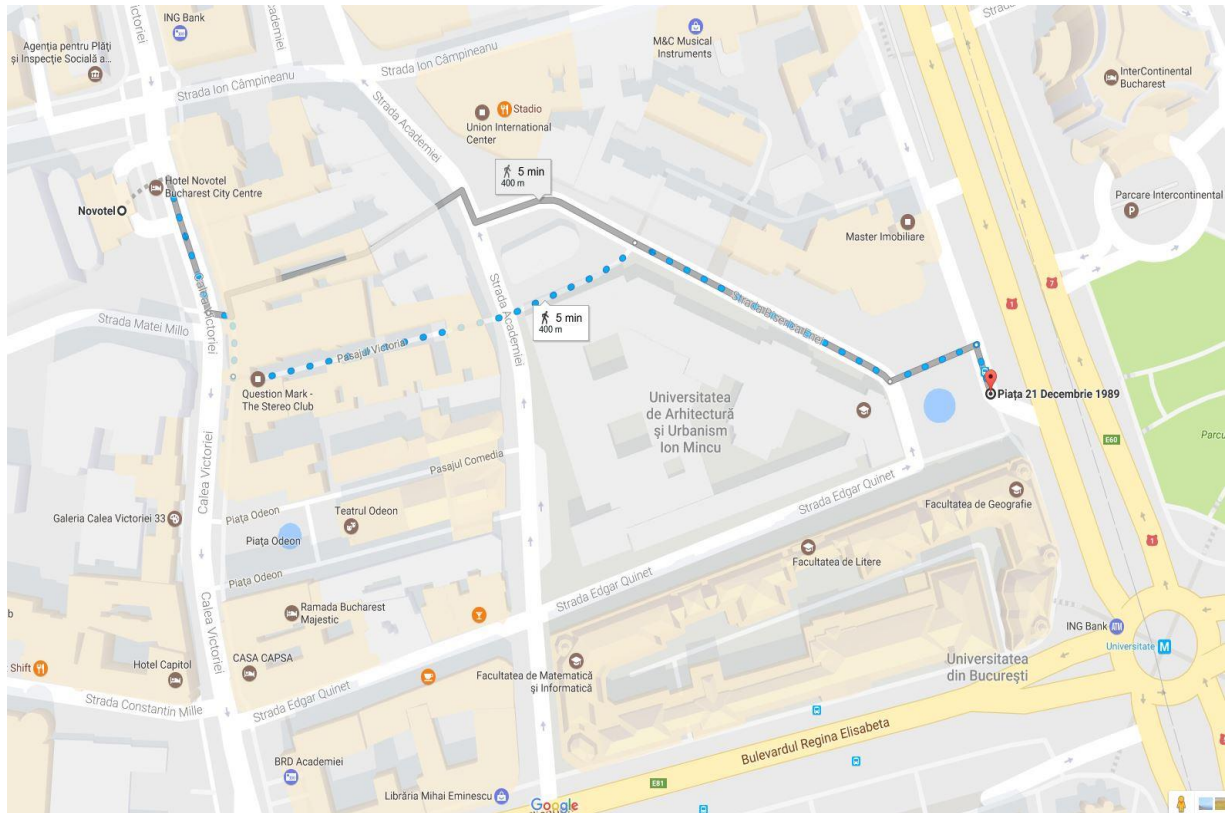
How to reach the conference place (Novotel Bucharest City Center Hotel)

By Bus (public transportation)

Take the 783 Express line from Bucharest Henri Coandă International Airport to the city center. The bus stop is in front of the Arrivals Terminal and Departures Terminal. The bus runs every 20 minutes during the day, 40 minutes during the night and it takes 35-45 minutes to get to the city center. The price for one trip is 3,5 lei (about 0.8€). Tickets can be bought at the card desk in front of the Arrivals Terminal. Make sure your ticket is validated before boarding the bus. The closest bus station to our conference place is **PIATA 21 DECEMBRIE 1989** or **UNIVERSITATE**.

By Taxi

As of Wednesday, June 15, 2016, licensed taxis without prior request, with fares of up to up 1.40 lei/km, will be available for passengers arriving at Bucharest Henri Coandă International Airport. These cars will be situated in a taxi station located at the exit of the terminal and will take passengers in order of arrival.

The touch screen terminals for taxi requests will still be available for customers who want to order taxi from a certain company.

Licensed taxi cars with fares between 1.39 lei/km and 3.5 lei/km are available on the ground floor, in front of the Arrivals terminal.

Each of the taxi stations - taxi with a maximum fare of 1.40 lei/km, for taxi on request and for other taxis - will be clearly signposted.

You should avoid people who offer you a ride, and head straight to the taxi booths. There read well before ordering the rates of each company on offer as it can be from simple to double. The number on your ticket shows the plate number of the car, that you need to check.
