May 3- Morris Bridge Park - west side

THE CLASS LOCATIONS

The locations for each class are all Hillsborough County Parks located in Thonotosassa on Morris Bridge Road clustered near the I-75 Fletcher (Rte 579) exit. When you take the exit, turn east (left). This is where the old Morris Bridge Road starts. All the parks are within 3 miles of the exit- very easy to find. Morris Bridge Road (Rte 579) extends north into Pasco County and Zephyrhills. The following directions are from the I-75 Fletcher Ave. exit:

Mar 22- Wilderness Park, Trout Creek Site: cross the canal, 1st park on your left; at the end of the winding driveway is a parking lot- we'll meet near the picnic shelter/ restrooms on the left edge. We'll paint along the river.

April 5- Flatwoods Park- go past Trout Creek, through the little village; after crossing Morris Bridge drive for 1 1/4 mi. & look for the small county brown sign on right. This park's entrance has become obscured by tree growth so right after the brown county sign turn LEFT into the driveway quickly; straight down the road is the Interpretive station (w/bathrooms & exhibits) where we'll meet. Then we'll drive further in to a paint spot.

April 12- Wilderness Park: Trout Creek Site- back to this familiar painting place- except this time, after we meet, we'll go into the interior for our paint spot.

May 3 - Morris Bridge Park - West Side - pass Trout Creek, pass thru the little village and out thru SWFMD land- you'll see signs for "Four Rivers Basin" just before you get to the bridge- turn LEFT into the drive towards the restrooms. We'll meet in the parking area and choose from a variety of lush scenery for paint spots!

(All workshops are from 10am- 1pm \$30 per workshop Canvas provided)
