Official Rules

The 66th annual *HOLSTEIN WORLD* Junior All-American Awards will be made in 2016 under the following rules.

Classes Recognized (16)

Spring Heifer Calf	(born after Feb. 29, 2016 and over four months of age)
Winter Heifer Calf	(born Dec. 1, 2015 - Feb. 29, 2016)
Fall Heifer Calf	(born Sept. 1 - Nov. 30, 2015)
Summer Yearling Heifer	(born Jun. 1 - Aug. 31, 2015)
Spring Yearling Heifer	(born Mar. 1 - May 31, 2015)
Winter Yearling Heifer	(born Dec. 1, 2014 - Feb. 28, 2015)
Fall Yearling Heifer	(born Sept. 1 - Nov. 30, 2014)
Fall Yearling In Milk	(must have freshened) born after Aug. 31, 2014)
Junior Two-Year-Old Cow	(must have freshened) born Mar. 1 - Aug. 31, 2014)
Senior Two-Year-Old Cow	(must have freshened) born Sept. 1, 2013 - Feb. 28, 2014)
Junior Three-Year-Old Cow	(born Mar. 1 - Aug. 31, 2013)
Senior Three-Year-Old Cow	(born Sept. 1, 2012 - Feb. 28, 2013)
Four-Year-Old Cow	(born Sept. 1, 2011 - Aug. 31, 2012)
Five-Year-Old Cow	(born Sept. 1, 2010 - Aug. 31, 2011)
Aged Cow	(born before Sept. 1, 2010)
150,000-lb. Cow	

**To be eligible for this class, the animal must qualify in a 150,000-Lb. class. List only placings from the class entered in the contest. In no case will the same animal be eligible for the 150,000-Lb. class and the Aged Cow class in the same year.*

***Yearling heifers that have freshened and are shown in milk must be entered in the Fall Yearling in Milk class. Animals may qualify for entry in this class on the basis of their placings in a milking class and/or as an unrefreshed heifer earlier in the season.*

(Right is reserved to combine classes at our own discretion for balanced competition of entries received)

Ownership

Each animal competing must be registered in the Herd Book of the Holstein Association USA in the name of its Junior exhibitor and meet the requirements of Junior project work and for exhibition at 4-H, FFA, or Junior state shows or fairs.

JUNIORS MAY SELL THEIR ANIMALS THROUGHOUT THE SHOW SEASON TO AN ADULT MEMBER AND THE ANIMAL MAY BE SHOWN UNDER AN ADULT NAME DURING THE SAME SHOW SEASON. This entry form is strictly for the junior show/placings at which that animal showed at under a JUNIOR's ownership.

Title By June 1, 2016

Title of all animals in this competition must be shown on the registry certificate with ownership recorded by June 1, 2016 as shown by the filing date on the transfer. **A PHOTOCOPY OF THE REGISTRY CERTIFICATE FOR THE ANIMAL BEING ENTERED MUST ACCOMPANY THIS FORM AND SHOULD CLEARLY SHOW THE OWNERSHIP RECORD AND TRANSFER DATES.** All ownership records will be checked by Holstein Association USA and their decision on eligibility under this rule will be final.

Partnership Animals

Upon recommendation of the Holstein Association USA and in line with the rules for 4-H exhibition in the great majority of shows, **all entries must stand on the Association records in the individual name of the exhibitor.** Senior-Junior family partnerships will not be acceptable. However, two junior exhibitors may own an animal in partnership if the animal is exhibited by the partnership throughout the show season.

Qualification For Entry

To qualify for entry in the Junior All-American Contest an animal must meet one or the other of the requirements listed below:

- Place first or second Junior in District, State or Regional Show in the United States **or**
- Place anywhere in class in one of the nationally accredited junior shows listed on the entry form

If a junior meets either criterion, they are eligible to enter the contest.

Picture Requirements

All photos should be submitted as high resolution (300dpi) digital images from the photographer.

Together with a completed entry form, owners must also submit suitable pictures of their animals qualified for entry in the All-American. Pictures must be taken in the current year and show animals in substantially the same stage as when making their show ring appearance.

How To Enter

Entry is completed by emailing a suitable picture of each eligible animal, together with this form and a copy of the Registry Certificate to cmoyer@dairybusiness.com • Online entries www.holsteinworld.com
Closing date for the receipt of entries in the Junior All-American Contest is Nov. 1, 2016. ***In case of any fall show whose date would make it impossible to comply with this deadline, special arrangements will be made. Please notify HolsteinWorld of pending entries 1.800.334.1904 ext.8.***

The Awards

All entries will be given consideration by the All-American Nominating Committee, which will select the top six animals in each class for nomination. The pictures of the nominated animals will then be submitted for a final vote. Nominations and winners will be announced in the February issue of *DairyBusiness&HolsteinWorld*.
