At the top floor of the shopping center "The Castle" on Schloss-Straße you will find the Ingeborg Drewitz Library. The bright, spacious library has a total of 215,000 media items, including 54,000 media units for children and adolescents. The location on the shopping street Schloss-Straße has several advantages, which may be one of the reasons why this library is one of the few in Berlin with increasing rental figures, and the second highest visitor count in the capital (after the Central and Regional Library). Our focus is on working with children and adolescents and the music library.
