Not far from Kollwitzplatz, in the popular neighborhood of Prenzlauer Berg, is the cultural and educational center “Sebastian Haffner” with the “Library at the Wasserturm” (water tower).

With its inviting reading platform in the cozy children's area and its versatile afternoon program, the library is a popular place to stay and a meeting place for the leisure time activities of families with children.

Pupils and youth groups meet for joint learning and just to “chill”, students and young creatives use the open WLAN and the numerous work stations as a co-working space.



The library is place of welcome, meeting and learning, for all newly arrived and learners of German in the neighborhood, and it cooperates with local actors in many projects to promote bi- and multilingualism.

As a special welcome service, the library offers a “Welcome-Walk” through the neighborhood in English and German. Next Library® participants of this library visit tour will have the chance to participate in such a walk after the official library visit (optional).
