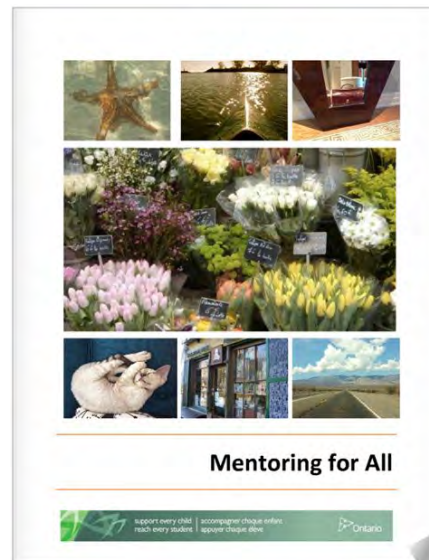


Foundational Elements of Mentorship
