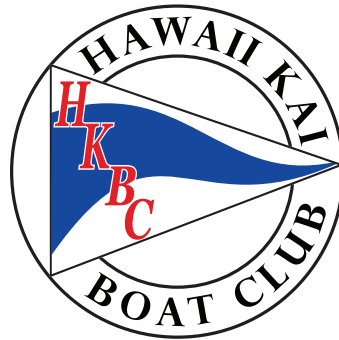

1 Sign on and Sign Off

- 1.1 Each competitor shall sign on as instructed at the All Fleets Briefing to be held at 1030hrs on Thursday 29th March 2018.
- 1.2 Competitors shall sign off within 15 minutes of coming ashore.
- 1.3 Failing to sign off may result in a DNE score without a hearing unless the Chief Umpire decides otherwise. This changes rule A5.
- 1.4 A boat retiring shall inform the race committee as soon as possible.


2 Signals Made Ashore


- 2.1 Will be displayed from the main flagmast in front of **HAWAII KAI BOAT CLUB**
- 2.2 When AP  is lowered ashore, the warning signal will be made not less than 30 minutes later. This changes race signals AP.

3 Notices to Competitors

- 3.1 Will be posted on the board located inside **HAWAII KAI BOAT CLUB**
- 3.2 Competitor briefings will be held Island Brew Coffeehouse, 377 Keahole St #C2, Hawaii Kai

4 Changes to the Sailing Instructions

4.1 Any change made afloat will be identified by the display of International Code Flag 3rd Substitute  with three sound signals. The change will be advised verbally.

4.2 Any change made ashore will be identified by the display of International Code Flag L  with 1 sound at least 30 minutes prior to any race affected.

5 Class Flags

5.1 Gold Fleet	Gold flag with Open Bic logo
Silver Fleet	Silver flag with Open Bic logo
Bronze Fleet	Green flag with Open Bic logo
Laser fleet	Laser Flag with Laser Class Logo
29er Fleet	29er Flag with 29er Class Logo
Rs Feva Fleet	RS Feva flag with Rs Feva Class Logo

5.2 Any signal displayed above these flags applies to that fleet only.

6 Start / Finish and Marks





6.1 The start line is between the orange flag on the race committee boat at the starboard end and Orange mark at the port end.

6.2 The finish line will be between the Red mark at the port end and a Finish boat displaying a Blue flag.

6.3 Course marks 1,3 and 4 will be yellow inflatable marks. Marks 1,3 and 4 may be substituted with Gates. Mark 2 will be a FWD WIP Red inflatable mark with horns to make it easily identified by Silver Fleet.

7 Start Sequence – amends rule 26

Point score races will be started separately for each fleet.

3 minutes to start "Warning Signal"	Class Flag ↑ with one sound
2 minutes to start "Preparatory Signal"	 ↑ with one sound
1 minute to start	 ↑  ↓ with one sound
Start	Class Flag +  ↓ with one sound

NOTE: Starting Penalties under rule 30, ie: I, Z, Black and U may still be made in conjunction with the 2 minute signal

8 Courses

Will be indicated by a numeral board or Numeral pennant displayed on the committee vessel.

9 Rules – refer NoR 1

The SI's shall take precedence over the NoR if there is any conflict. Changes rule 63.7

10 Advertising – refer NoR 2

11 Race Areas/Venue

Bronze fleet may sail within the Marina

12 Scoring – refer NoR 13

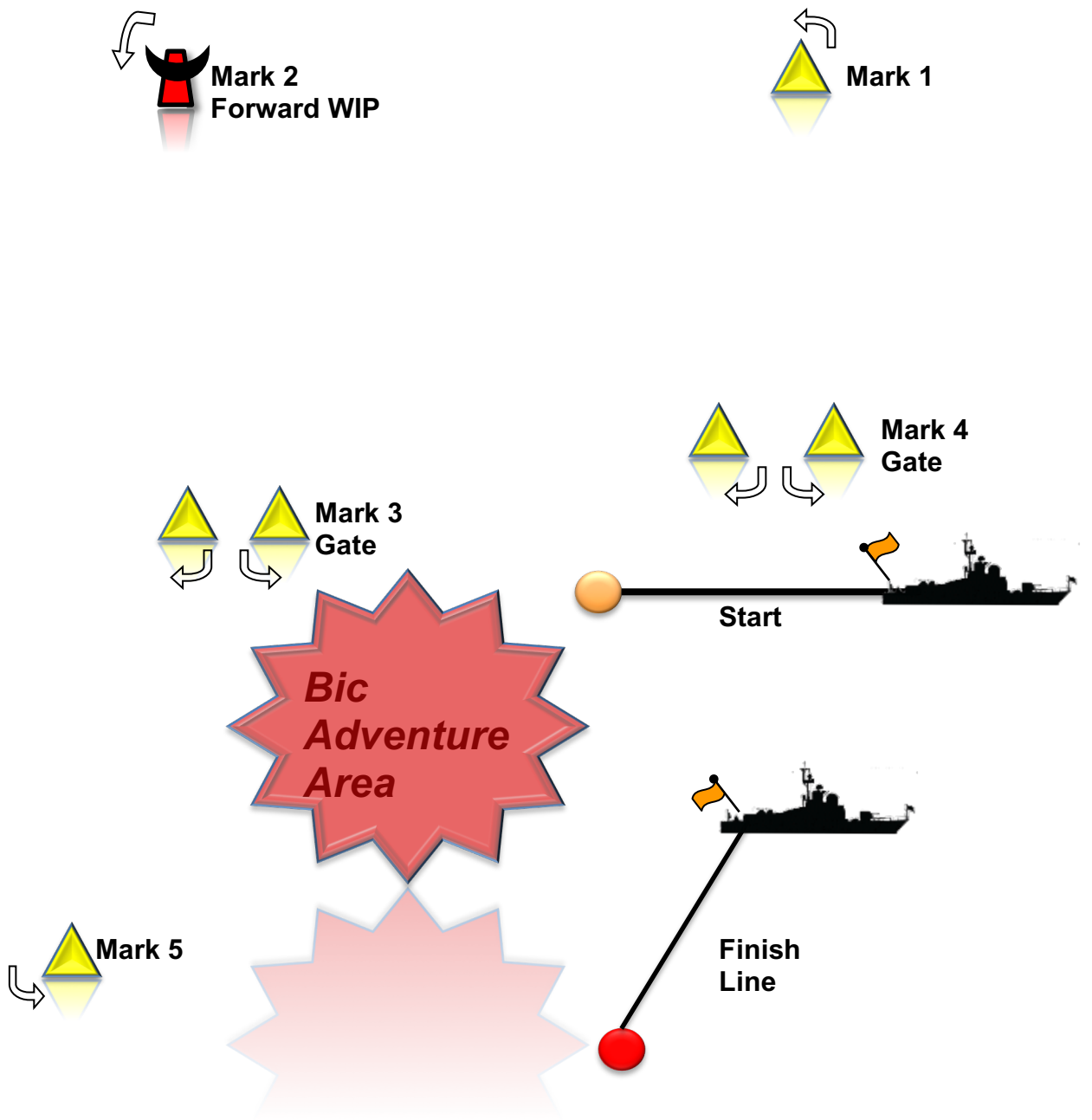
A number of novelty type races may be conducted.

Bic Silver	2-3-adventure-F	5th start 1min
