Driven by our desire to empower black entrepreneurs in South Africa, we launch Zimele, our first enterprise development scheme. Over the next **25 YEARS**, Zimele creates a total of **SIX FUNDS**.

EXPANDING INTO CHILE: 2006

Building on the success of Zimele in South Africa, we decide to expand to Chile. EMERGE also provides access to capital but focuses on business advisory and mentoring with a **“THREE TIER”** approach that matches different levels of entrepreneur maturity and allows them to **“GRADUATE”** from one level to the other.

INNOVATION 2007

Zimele introduces the concept of **BUSINESS HUBS** and over the next seven years, we create 30 community-based centres for business development across South Africa.

GLOBAL VISION 2012

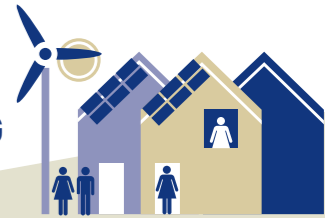
Recognising the fundamental role of enterprise development in the success of our own business, our leadership endorses a **GLOBAL FRAMEWORK** that can be tailored to different countries.

GLOBAL EXPANSION 2013

Supported by our global framework, we launch schemes in **BOTSWANA, BRAZIL, and PERU**. Working with the government in Botswana we focus on diversification of the economy. In Brazil and Peru we focus on farming and other strategic sectors.

PIONEERING 2014

We create a **HOUSING CONCEPT** which will provide capital to customised houses to generate an income stream that will cover most of the cost of the property; and a **LOW CARBON CONCEPT** which will allow SMEs to trade low carbon technologies and self-finance their growth via carbon credits.
