

A Petition to Congress to Defund the Refugee Resettlement Program

Whereas,

We the people consider the resettlement of refugees from the Middle East, Africa, and any other terrorist sponsoring nations to be of the most urgent concern. It involves vital issues of national security, personal safety, the economy, healthcare, education, our culture, and identity as a country by using public taxpayer funds; and,

Whereas,

FBI Director James Comey declares the appropriate vetting of Syrian refugees to be impossible, and Defense Intelligence Agency Director Stewart states ISIS will attempt direct attacks in 2016 in the U.S.; and,

Whereas,

Islamic terrorists have exploited the refugee program in the past to gain access to our country and claim they will continue to do so; and,

Whereas,

The funding for this program is largely the responsibility of the Federal Government, with the economic burden falling to the local, citizen taxpayer in regards to the welfare of the refugee rendering this program unsustainable and unacceptable to the American worker; and,

The cost of caring for the refugee in close proximity to their home country costs one-twelfth the amount as relocating them to America, we the people demand Congress take a leading role in establishing care for the refugee in geographically suitable safe havens; and,

Now Therefore, Be It Resolved That,

The Congress shall immediately pass a bill with veto majority that defunds the Refugee Resettlement Program until Americans' interests are put first; and,
