A **glyph** is an element of writing, usually a letter. In archaeology, a glyph is a carved or inscribed symbol.

A **transliteration** is the process of mapping letters from one alphabet into another alphabet. (See [Evolution of the English Alphabet Chart](#) and [Alphabet Family Tree](#))

A **transcription** is the process of matching the *sounds* of human speech to letters. (See blogs on [The Sound of Ancient Hebrew](#) and [Ancient Hebrew – The First SMS Language](#).)

\*Unless at the end of a word or if a vowel-letter (other than 'a') is after it. [This rule only applies only to consonants – ie not al, ea, uu, id and on. (See [Ancient Hebrew – The First SMS Language](#).)]

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
