

Bachelor of Theology

Bachelor of Theology (B.Th.) is the primary degree offered by **WGIU**, embodying the original purpose for the founding of the university. Similar to a four-year Bachelor of Arts degree, this is a two-year accelerated Bible university degree designed to give students a solid foundation in the Bible and Christian life. It will prepare each student to serve God effectively in whatever capacity the Lord may require in the future. The following courses and units are required to earn the Bachelor of Theology degree:

With a full time load of 12 units per quarter, a student can complete the Bachelor of Theology degree requirements in two school years. Academic reviews must be cleared.

Upon graduating with a Bachelor of Theology degree, following the laying on of hands by the ministerial staff and completing credentials, the graduate will receive a minister's ordination card to work as a certified ordained minister and perform all ministerial functions.
