INDOCTRINATION IN MESA SCHOOLS

We just started the Education Action Committee 2 weeks ago and already we have discovered a lot of information regarding the indoctrination of our school children through the taxpayer funded **International Baccalaureate** school program and the **New Global Citizens** after school program.

International Baccalaureate

1. **International Baccalaureate (IB) is an international system of education.**
 - It is run by a non-governmental organization (NGO) in Geneva, Switzerland
 - IB programs in 90 countries worldwide.
 - Exams are sent to other parts of the world [after being sent to Geneva] for grading.
 - [Grading] is based on an international standard.
 - IBO trains and certifies teachers for IB at the expense of the local school district, of course.
2. **International Baccalaureate promotes world citizenship.**
3. **International Baccalaureate views state education standards as being subservient to, and interpreted by, the worldview of IB.**
4. **International Baccalaureate endorses the [UN Universal Declaration of Human Rights \[UDHR\]](#).**
5. **By endorsing the UDHR, IBO has agreed to promote the United Nations along with the actions and treaties of the United Nations.** IBO promotes the actions and treaties of the UN not ratified by, the United States:
 - Biodiversity Treaty
 - Treaty on the Rights of the Child
 - Agenda 21
 - Kyoto Treat
 - Treaty establishing the United Nations International Criminal Court.
6. **By endorsing the UDHR, IBO promotes the United Nations as being the highest court of appeals on issues of human rights.**
7. **By endorsing the UDHR, IBO undermines the foundation principle of the United States**
8. **IBO also [endorses the Earth Charter](#),**
 - **Not ratified by the United States** The Earth Charter is housed in the Arc of Hope and is correctly identified by the World Pantheist Association as a Pantheistic document. Besides Pantheism, the Earth Charter advocates:
 1. The redistribution of wealth between nations and within nations [Art. 10.a.]
 2. Same-sex marriage [Art. 12.a.]
 3. Spiritual education [Art 14.d.] which means education in Pantheism.
 4. Military disarmament [Art. 16.d.&c.]
 5. Creation of an international agency to make the Earth Charter binding on all nations [in The Way Forward action-plan.]
9. **Many of the IBO instructional materials are now being written, or overseen, by the UN.**

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New Global Citizens

New Global Citizens is an after school global socialist indoctrination program in the Mesa public schools
