***Intervention for Autism Spectrum Disorders from the

With the alarming increase in the numbers of individuals receiving this diagnosis (believed to be 1 in every 88 children in the U.S.) there is increased urgency to provide effective services. This webinar will describe how school-based PBS interventions are constructed for these students and how this approach differs from more traditional approaches.
