ACCREDITATION TEAM

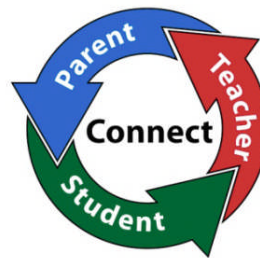
