

“FORWARD: 21 DAYS OF PRAYER AND FASTING”

This journal is a compilation of original prayers posted and distributed by the Jesus Saves Social Network for “Forward: 21 Days of Prayer and Fasting,” January 5 – 26, 2014, under the Scripture theme, “Your Kingdom Come, Your Will Be Done...” Luke 11:2. In addition to praying for God’s will to be done in 2014, prayers were offered for the homeless, unemployed, incarcerated; those with obesity and chronic disease, mental illness; those suffering in domestic violence; burdened with debt and education disparities, and for the lost to be saved.

Jesus Saves Ministries began 2014 with "Forward: 21 Days of Prayer and Fasting." Members of the Jesus Saves Social Network and a few of our new community partners sought God's will for our families, churches, communities and for Jesus Saves Ministries. The Bible gives us a number of promises for answered prayer and one of them is asking in agreement with God's will, "And this is the confidence that we have in him, that, if we ask anything according to his will, he heareth us" (1 John 5:14).

The theme was a portion of the "Model Prayer," also known as "The Lord's Prayer," in Luke 11:2 and Matthew 6:10, "*Your Kingdom come. Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven.*" Jesus never intended The Lord's Prayer to be recited verbatim, but rather as a model for effective, life-changing relationship with God. The significance of our focal passages is dependency and submission to the will of God. Also, the emphasis was not just to pray, but also fast as Jesus stated in Matthew 17:21 that some things will only come about with prayer and fasting.

Participants were asked to do the following:

Father, we ask that you speak into the mind of these individuals “You shall live and not die and declare the works of the Lord” (Ps 118:17). We decree and declare that every demonic force, every thought will line up to the obedience to God.
