Request a blood or skin biopsy collection kit. Contact:

Complete an informed consent, submission form and clinical data summary form. Enclose copies of relevant medical records and genetic test results, if available.



Have blood drawn or tissue biopsy taken. Coriell can reimburse up to \$40 for a blood draw but cannot reimburse for costs associated with biopsies. Biopsy samples can be collected during a scheduled surgical procedure.



Ship the sample and completed paperwork to Coriell. Ship for receipt Monday-Friday using the prepaid FedEx air bill.
